2019 Rough River Lake Cardboard Boat Regatta

Rules for Building an Eligible Boat:

- Boats must be made Entirely from cardboard. It may be any thickness, but must not be bonded to any other material including, but not limited to vinyl or wax (similar to what is used in packaging).
- The hull may NOT be covered in plastic sheeting, fiberglass, or other kind of resin, duct tape, epoxy glue or other multi-part glues or varnish materials.
- Joints and seams ONLY may be taped and/or glued. You may use glue, sealant, rubber or contact cement, paint or duct tape.
- NO metal, wood, Styrofoam or other types of foam or plastic may be used.
- Boats may not exceed 16 ft. in length.
- Boats will be inspected prior to racing. Judges reserve the right to disqualify boats for violations of the above rules. Their decision will be final with no appeal.
- HAVE FUN AND USE YOUR IMAGINATION!

Race Rules:

- If your boat sinks, you are disqualified from the race and should exit the water as soon as possible.
- Boats must be paddled with oars provided by participant – no motors or flippers.
- No participant may menace or harass another participant. Poor sportsmanship will result in disqualification.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed
- **All participants must provide and wear their own lifejackets. They will be tested to make sure they fit.**
