

## Kentucky Water-Ski Federation Minutes JULY 13, 2019

The meeting was called to order by President John Fowler. John welcomed ALL Federation members to Patriot Lake for our 2019 State tournament and thanked them for hosting the tournament.

The **minutes** from the July 2018 and November 2018 meetings were emailed to federation members. Copies were available for members to read. The minutes were approved as read.

The **treasurer's report** was given by Leon Leonard with a balance on December 1, 2018 was \$1,934.51. The expenses were \$1,194.16 and income (deposits) were \$975.00. The balance as of July 13 2019 was \$1,715.35. The treasurer's report was approved as reported.

Vice-President Joy gave the **membership report**. In 2017, we had 34 memberships, in 2018, we had 34 members, and in 2019, we have 46 memberships.

Joy Coomes, **KY Water-Ski State Championship and State Record Keeper**, reported those breaking KY State and State Tournament Records. So far, we have 2 records broken. In KY State Championships, Gary Gambrel broke the record with Tricks at 2,840 points, In KY State Championships and State Tournaments, Dave Keller broke the record with Tricks at 2,160 points). Bobby Hill, **Junior Development Director**, explained the KLO Jr. Development Clinic was held on June. We had 10 skiers participating in the clinic. In July, our one day clinic held at Patriot Lake, had 6 skiers participating. Our Junior Skiers continue to work hard and make Kentucky look good!
