Marlow Town Council's neglected plot inspection

Later this month a representative of the Town Council will inspect plots at both sites with a view to identifying those which appear to be neglected. Letters to tenants of these plots will follow, reminding them of their obligations under the terms of the Tenancy Agreement. Neglected plots are a frequent cause of annoyance from neighbouring tenants and they may at any time address their complaints to the Town Council on 01628 484024. Plots which have received complaints will be inspected alongside all the others applying the same standards. The Town Council will always consider extenuating circumstances such as illness or family problems and deal with them sympathetically. If you are likely to be unable to look after your plot for an extended period for the above or related reasons please inform either the Association or the Town Council.

Date Protection Legislation.

Some if not most of you may be aware of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that comes into force on 25 May. We think it may apply to Marlow Allotments Association in so far as we will probably have to ask your permission before we contact you by email, phone or post, including sending you a Newsletter. Once we have established if this is required we will be contacting you.

We request a small donation of £1 for tenants who attend, to go towards covering the cost of the insurance policy we are obliged to have. Access to the site will be facilitated for Foxes Piece tenants.

All varieties are available loose - so you are not restricted to purchasing a set weight.
