Seed Scheme

Spotted Wing Drosophila

This fruit fly, which was first reported in the UK in 2012, can damage a wide range of fruit, including cherries, plums and raspberries. The female penetrates the skin of the fruit and lays eggs under the surface, which turn into larvae and then damage the fruit. An otherwise bumper cherry crop on the Hanging Hill site was badly affected by this fly during the summer. More details including control measures can be found at
