FENCER VISIT

updated on August 2016

This is at the core of Global Fencing Network promise. We would like to keep it simple and minimize bureaucracy. A fencer of a GFN club can fence at no cost for 2 weeks in designated open fencing hours at any other club in the network that is at least 250 km or 150 miles away from home club.

Check list

Visiting Fencer

Pre-Visit

- Find a club at our website www.globalfencing.net
- Or contact ambassadors in host country to find a host club
- ***Contact host club via email and confirm travel dates***
- ***Copy Home club as proof of membership***
- ***Arrange Travel Health Insurance if travelling abroad***
- ***Check other insurance or License requirements with Hosting Club***

During Visit

- Comply with Host Club rules
- Sign any waiver of liability that is required

Hosting Club

Pre-Visit

- Reply to email from visiting fencer with available dates and hours for open fencing in their weapon
- Validate that their home club is copied in the email and is a member of GFN
- Inform her or him of any local requirements in terms of insurance or license

During Visit

- Welcome the visiting fencer and introduce them to the local fencers
- Show her/him your facilities and explain any club rules that could be relevant
- Provide any paper work that might be required
