The Feast of Corpus Christi

The feast of Corpus Christi commemorates the institution and gift of the Holy Eucharist, given to us by our Lord at the Last Supper and is the sacrament through which Christians experience the Real Presence of Christ. St Cyprian wrote, 'where the Eucharist is, there is the Church.'

This feast day has always been important in the Newland calendar and we have accounts from the early days of St Leonard's of processions around the church and village green. This year we shall once again maintain this great tradition with High Mass, Solemn Choral Evensong, Benediction and Procession.

Sunday 18 at 6.00pm : The celebration continues
Solemn Choral Evensong, Procession and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

Experience the rare and mystical beauty of Choral Evensong, in which the Word is illuminated through choral music and ceremonial followed by the exquisitely beautiful service of Benediction, together the procession of the Blessed Sacrament around the church.

Both these services together last just over the hour with a glass of wine afterwards in the Boardroom and we hope to welcome a small group of professional musicians to sing the service. Further details of this will be posted in the porch in due course.
