Enroll in a TN community college or technical college (TCAT) that accepts the TN Promise. (Some universities accept the grant under certain conditions. See Promise Handbook for school list. Contact post-secondary school for guidelines.)

For ALL college applications: Most institutions give you access to a portal or school email account that provides you with important information and deadlines. If they don't have their own, then you should have submitted one to them so that they can contact you . . .

Check it REGULARLY!!!!!!!!!! You should be getting regular communication from schools to which you have applied and /or have been accepted.

Housing – Housing deadlines are approaching for many schools! Check your portal or college email account to stay current and get a better dorm assignment!

IMPORTANT! You must request your transcripts at: <https://sumnertn.scriborder.com/>. This includes transcripts for all college applications, college athletics (NCAA, NAIA), job applications and scholarships. Even though a school may offer a transcript service such as SendEdu, **you must use the Sumner Scrib Order service instead.**

Award Opportunity: Tennessee Scholars

**Deadline for application to be received in the counseling office is
March 1, 2018.**

Online survey (on the website) deadline is March 1.

A certificate and a medal that can be worn at the graduation ceremony will be awarded to each recipient. According to the website, other benefits are:

1. Up to \$1500 per year Union University scholarship
2. \$500 Bryan College scholarship
3. \$300 TN College of Applied Technology scholarship
4. East TN State Univ. – inquire at ETSU
5. Student should always ask the college/university to which they apply if extra dollars are available to Tennessee Scholars.

Requirements for Tennessee Scholars

All state graduation requirements must be met (with no substitutions). Special Notes:

Math: Bridge Math does NOT count as a 4th Math for TN Scholars, SAILS math does count.

Science: Two of the three credits must be Biology and Chemistry.

Additional Workforce Development Requirements

No Out of School Suspensions

95% attendance for 4 years (No more than 36 total days missed in 4 years)

Maintain a C or above average in all classes. (If an F was earned, the class should have been retaken to meet the requirement.)

Perform 80 hours or more **volunteer service hours to help your community**. These hours must be done before school or after school and cannot be counted as a grade or for pay. Mission trips can be counted as 8 hours per day you work for a maximum of 40 hours. Please make sure you keep a log of your hours.
