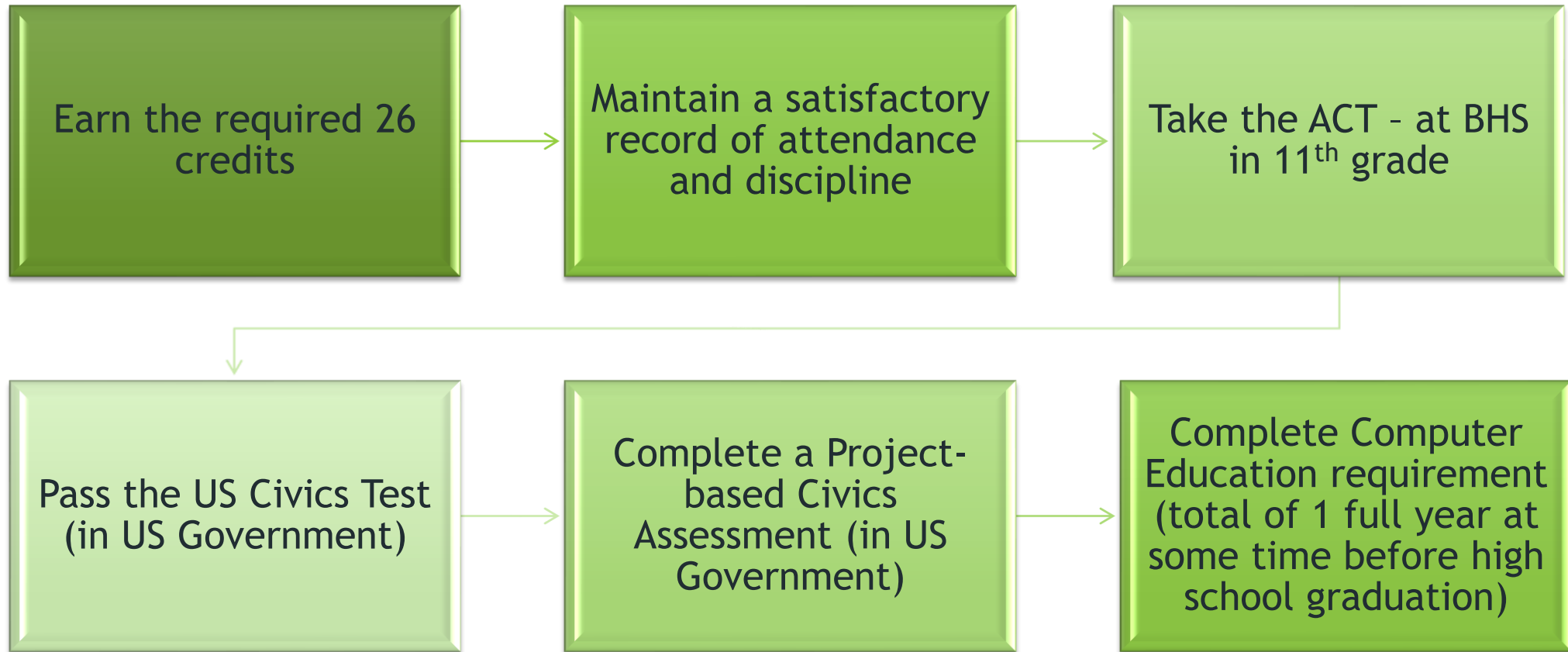

Graduation Requirements - Class of 2021



Process

- ▶ Meetings with students in skinny block
- ▶ Registration materials distributed
 - ▶ Course registration card (**blue**) / directions (signatures)
 - ▶ Course List and BHS AP Info
 - ▶ Unofficial Transcript
 - ▶ Student Profile Verification Page for personal info verification
 - ▶ Early Post-Secondary Letter from State
- ▶ Discuss with parents

Early Post Secondary Opportunity:

- ▶ Dual Enrollment
- ▶ Dual Credit
- ▶ Advancement Placement
- ▶ Certification Programs (CNA)

Process

- ▶ Meetings with students in skinny block
- ▶ Registration materials distributed
- ▶ Discussion with parents
- ▶ Honors classes – signatures **BEFORE** registration meeting
- ▶ **Course selections - completed per directions- 8 top choices + 1 skinny block and alternates for electives/skinny**



Turn in all paperwork to the
School Counseling Office by
March 15. (signed!).

Completed Registration Cards, proofs of
residence, and profiles (course #'s, course
titles, etc.)

Course Selection:

- ▶ English III or equivalent (* on course list)
- ▶ Math - even if you have taken 4 math credits.
- ▶ US History and Geography
- ▶ 3rd Science
 - ▶ Chemistry or Physics is required if not already taken, another if already taken
- ▶ Personal Finance / PE (9 weeks of each)
- ▶ Complete or continue **ELECTIVE FOCUS** if not already complete.

IMPORTANT - CTE Focus Area :

- ▶ Your CTE elective focus is complete if you have earned 3 or more credits in a **concentrated area**.
- ▶ See page 32 of the Registration Book.
 - ▶ Example 1 – Agriculture is not an elective focus. Horticulture Science is an elective focus.
 - ▶ Example 2 – Marketing - No. Entrepreneurship - YES
 - ▶ Example 3 – Health Science – No, Nursing Ed - YES

Dual Enrollment . . . Earn College Credit While in High School

- ▶ Student is enrolled both in BHS and the college. Credit can be received at both institutions for the class.
- ▶ Class tuition and book fees may be required.
- ▶ Upon graduation, a college transcript must be requested for credits to be transferred to another institution.



Dual Enrollment with Volunteer State Community College

- ▶ Classes meet two or three days a week at BHS (off days - students find a teacher to whom they can be assigned)
- ▶ GPA and ACT requirement for each class - see BHS Registration Book
- ▶ Deadline for online Vol State Application, online Dual Enrollment Grant application, and paperwork to be turned in to school counseling office:
March 15.

Student Profile Verification Page

Registration is COMPLETE when the parent signs and student returns this item to the School Counseling Office with TWO Proofs of Residence and the registration card.

Proofs of residence:

- ▶ Current Utility Bill (last 30 days)
- ▶ Renters Insurance / Homeowners Insurance
- ▶ Current lease agreement / Mortgage statement

Beech High School Junior Registration is COMPLETE when . . .

- ▶ Complete Process =
 - ✓ Card is Complete (in pencil)
 - ✓ **Blue Registration Card** is signed by all parties and returned . . .
 - ✓ With **2** proofs of residence AND profile page
