Trail Day

Adoption Exchange

- The volunteer spreadsheet is almost full, we still need a few corner marshals and drivers
- Silvio will get with Dave Green to complete the gift certificates for the prizes
- Joanna will get the magnets from Steve and will keep them at the house
- Steve has indicated the podium sign is in the works with Fast Signs
- Kevin Phelan is heading up the Crit Management, Silvio and Chris discussed looking at Crit Setup either the immediate Friday before (4/1) or a week prior.
- Dennis Chavez has committed to sending the results of the race to USAC, Joanna will coordinate with him.
- Silvio would like a Twitter account set up for the race. Joanna will look into this and make sure it is all linked to our website.
- Joanna will be posting results for the race using webscorer, this will all be linked on the website and through facebook communication as well.
- The breakeven number for not losing money on the race is ~120, Silvio will confirm.
- Silvio reminded Chris to bring the checkbook to the race to pay the officials.

Finances

- We received our confirmation from the IRS that we are officially a non-profit (CRS number received)
- We had received State approval months ago.

- There is currently ~\$4200 in the bank account

 - Non-Profit Costs
- We have the bank account set up at Wells Fargo, there is a minimum of \$500 required in the account to not accrue charges.

Clothing

- All regular team clothing is in process
- The cyclocross suits are slightly delayed due to accommodating the state stripe requests
- The clothing should be here just in time for the Adoption Exchange.
- We purchased \$1500-\$1600 in extra clothing to meet minimums. Some of this clothing is already spoken for.

- For now, we agree to ask teammates to wear a sock that will fit with the kit. If they have one of our sponsors (Sport Systems, Elevate, P2M, etc) that would be great.

 - We have received a quote from Asics (\$7.50 SS and \$11 LS), will look into printing costs on those
- Bags
 - Joanna ordered a messenger bag from Casteli for an example. It is canvas and we want to see how much it will cost to personalize (embroider or screenprint). The bag was <\$20.
- Damian mentioned talking to Aiken printing about Ogeo bags, this was ordered in the past for Mountaintop Cycling.
