Strawberry Plaza Art Board Program Overview

The Strawberry Plaza Art Board Program provides a systematic process for the creation, selection and display of art on six (6) large-sized art panels (4’ x 8’) affixed to the north and south walls of Lebanon’s Strawberry Plaza, the City’s downtown art-themed pocket park.

Once the program is fully implemented each selected work of art will be displayed for a 12-month period. The process for the replacement of each piece will be staggered such that every two months a new piece is introduced to the Plaza. The panels initially selected may be displayed for more or less than a year until the staggered replacement process can be fully implemented.

The program is administered through the Lebanon Downtown Association (LDA) Arts Committee. Selection of art work will occur using this application. All proposals will be created in miniature (in scale with the large boards) on this application. The Committee shall act as a jury in selecting works for display.

Once a work is selected, the artist will be asked to create their proposed work within 90 days on a 4’ x 8’ board provided by the LDA. All works must be made with weather resistant materials and for either landscape or portrait orientated display on a wall in an outdoor environment. All selected pieces become the property of the LDA. Artists may be asked, if necessary, to repair and/or refresh a piece during its 12-month display period.

During the 12-month public display of each piece of art the public will be given the opportunity to participate in a silent auction for the eventual purchase of the piece (once it is retired from Strawberry Plaza). Proceeds from the sale will be split, with 50% shares distributed to the LDA Arts Committee Art Fund and the artist.

Art Panel Selection Process Rules and Guidelines

- All proposed art board works must be submitted using the design template provided on the “Official Entry Form” included with these rules and guidelines.
- The artist must specify the materials to be used and may provide additional narrative describing their inspiration and subject matter.
- Multiple entries from the same artist are welcome.
- Designs with elements covered by copyright, trademark or other rights must include a release acceptable to the LDA
- All design submissions and any art panels resulting from the selection process become the property of the LDA and cannot be returned.
- Through the act of submitting an art board proposal, contest participants agree to produce a 4’ x 8’ art panel containing the proposed design within 90 days of notice of acceptance.

Strawberry Plaza Art Board Program Overview

The Strawberry Plaza Art Board Program provides a systematic process for the creation, selection and display of art on six (6) large-sized art panels (4’ x 8’) affixed to the north and south walls of Lebanon’s Strawberry Plaza, the City’s downtown art-themed pocket park.

Once the program is fully implemented each selected work of art will be displayed for a 12-month period. The process for the replacement of each piece will be staggered such that every two months a new piece is introduced to the Plaza. The panels initially selected may be displayed for more or less than a year until the staggered replacement process can be fully implemented.

The program is administered through the Lebanon Downtown Association (LDA) Arts Committee. Selection of art work will occur using this application.
