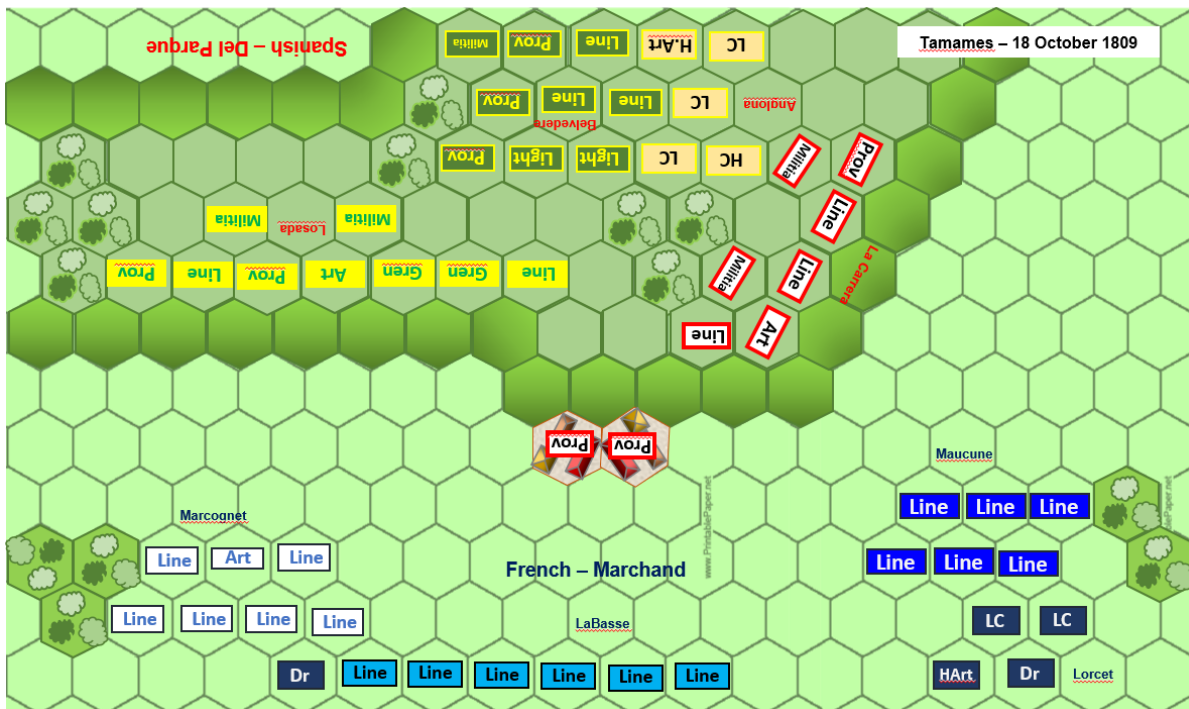


Battle of Tamames – 18 October 1809

Scenario rules

Background

To the surprise of the French Spanish General Del Parque had managed to gather a sizeable army and was advancing. French General Marchand, temporarily in charge of Marshall Ney's VI Corps moved to attack. The Spanish were in a good defensive position but Marchand was positive his better trained troops would prevail.

Organisation

The French have four corps for activation purposes. The Spanish have four corps. All Spanish infantry units can use the Rally rule.

Terrain Rules

Stands on a hill slope attacking stands on the hill top are attacking uphill. The hill slopes are difficult terrain for cavalry when moving and in combat. Hill crest rules for infantry fire are used.

Victory Conditions.

The French must break the Spanish to win. Otherwise it is a Spanish victory.
