

Battle of Stockach - 25 March 1799.

Background

French General Jourdan had advanced with the Army of the Danube to Lake Constance on the upper Rhine river. His aim was to cut off the Austrian lines of communication through Switzerland into Northern Italy and link up with General Massena. Austrian Archduke Charles moved to block this advance. Charles was expecting that the French would withdraw and initially only sent out a reconnaissance in force.

Scenario rules

Organisation

Both sides have four corps for activation purposes.

Terrain

Hill tops give uphill advantages against attackers on the slopes and they provide crests for infantry fire.

Victory Conditions

If neither side breaks the other within 30 turns the battle is a draw.
