“The Largest Single Vineyard in Northeastern Italy”

POINTS OF INTEREST

- The vineyards are part of a rare 'alpha climate' similar to those in Tuscany, Bordeaux and the Napa Valley.
- Before the 1950s the estate was a modern day “Little House on the Prairie”, with many different families living in a self-sufficient community around the ancient fountain, which remains today the heart of the estate.
- 999 Cypress trees line the vineyards.



ESTATE

Name: Estate on Bolani Road, named after the nobile Bolani Family.

Location: The estate is located between the mountains and Adriatic Sea in Cervignano del Friuli within the district of Aquileia in Northeastern Italy. Approximately two hours from Venice. The property has roughly 2,500 acres, 1,500 of which are dedicated to vineyards.

Elevation: Sea level.

Soil: Clay vein and alluvial gravel with good drainage.

Climate: Temperatures range from 39°- 41°F in the winter to 86°- 89°F in the summer similar to the climate in Bordeaux, France and Napa Valley, CA.

Training System: Spurred Cordon, Guyot, Double Tuscan Capovolto.

Vine Density: Approximately 3,600 - 5,500 vines per hectare.

Varietals: Glera, Pinot Grigio, Pinot Bianco, Tocai Friulano, Traminer Aromatico, Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Müller Thurgau, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Refosco dal Peduncolo Rosso.

HISTORICAL NOTES

Tenuta Ca' Bolani is situated in the heart of the Aquileia DOC appellation in Friuli in northeastern Italy. The property includes Molin di Ponte and Ca' Vescovo estates which have roots dating back to the 16th century. The noble Bolani family originally owned the property. Their most influential family member, Count Domenico Bolani, was the prosecutor for the Venetian Republic in Friuli. In 1970, the Zonin family acquired Tenuta Ca' Bolani, bringing it to the forefront of winemaking in the region. With 1,500 acres of vineyards, it is the Zonin family's largest property and the largest single vineyard in Friuli.
