LICENCES:

A **WOMZA** Interprovincial license is required to participate in the event (<u>www.womza2wheels.com</u> for online licensing).

Holders of WOMZA club/Regional licences are required to upgrade their licences to an interprovincial license before the event.

One-event licences available **BEFORE** the event (contact Fiona Jones: <u>fionaj1@telkomsa.net</u> and at registration on Saturday 22nd September at a cost of **R250**.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Make sure you have your own medical cover as **One Event Medical Cover** will **NOT** be available on the day. We however have yearly cover as per application forms. Should you not have cover you will be taken to a Government Hospital.

CLOSURE OF CIRCUIT:

Organisers and Clubs must close circuits on: Sunday 16th September <u>@ 18H00</u>. The responsibility for establishing if a circuit is open lies with the competitor.

ENTRY TO CIRCUIT:

Entrance to the grounds will be free for a (1) rider and (1) mechanic. The wrist band provided MUST be worn in order to gain free entry to the circuit, failing which you will be required to pay the gate entry fee. All other persons will need to pay an entry fee at the entrance to the venue, as decided on by the organising club

MINIMUM NUMBER OF STARTERS

The interprovincial team riders will be guaranteed entry to the event – thereafter the remaining gates will be allocated on a first come first served basis, up to a **maximum** of 40 riders.

PRACTICE / QUALIFYING:

50cc Junior, 50cc Senior	: 10 minutes
65cc, 85cc junior, Pro Mini, MX	3, Ladies, Sen support : 12 minutes
125cc H/S, MX 1,MX 2	: 12 minutes

RACE ORDER:

Race order and combination of classes is subject to change at the discretion of the COC. Each class will run 2 heats.

The duration of each heat for the Championship will be:

50cc Senior	- 8 minutes + 1 lap
50cc Junior	- 8 minutes + 1 lap
MX 3 (Vets)	 12 minutes + 1 lap
MX 3 (Masters, grandmasters)	 12 minutes + 1 lap
Ladies	 12 minutes + 1 lap
85cc Junior / Pro Mini	 12 minutes + 1 lap
MX 1	 15 minutes + 1 lap
65cc	 12 minutes + 1 lap
125cc High School	 14 minutes + 1 lap
MX 2	 15 minutes + 1 lap
Open Senior Support	 12 minutes + 1 lap

Classes that are combined on the day (as per the COC's decision) will be scored separately. Combining and separating of classes on the day shall be at the discretion of the COC, in conjunction with the jury, with safety being the foremost priority.

Race times may be reduced according to time constraints.

CLASSES

4 -7 (rider must STILL be 7 years old or younger on 31st December 2018)
7 – 9 (rider must STILL be 9 years old or younger on 31st December 2018)
7 – 12
8 – 13 (small wheels)
10 – 15
13 – 19 (rider MUST still be at high school) – 125cc engine capacity only
15 years and older (engines not exceeding 300cc 2 stroke and 450cc 4 stroke)
14 years and older (engines not exceeding 250cc four-stroke or 150cc 2 stroke)
30 – 38 (unrestricted engine capacity)
38 – 45 (unrestricted engine capacity)
45 and older (unrestricted engine capacity)
13 years and older: (2 stroke motorcycles not exceeding 126cc. Minimum wheel size 18" rear and 21" front) 14 years and older (Motorcycles not exceeding 250cc four stroke or 150cc 2 stroke) 15 years and older (Motorcycles not exceeding 300cc 2 stroke and 450cc 4 stroke)
Pro Mini (85cc big wheels) upwards

MX50cc Jnr/Snr classes:

Only ONE mechanic OR parent (wearing a dayglow bib) will be permitted on the junior track for the 50cc junior and 50cc senior races.

NO spectators will be allowed to stand on the junior track.

Spectators and supervised children may only stand in the designated spectator area next to the junior track.

In all other areas other than the race track and jetting area, riders must ride at a safe pace for the safety of pedestrians

<u>Ladies' scoring: 65cc</u> and 85cc small wheel lady team members should enter the class they race locally. The time keeper will extract the times and ladies will be "rank ordered" **and scored in the** ladies category.

QUALIFYING MXRR 2:

To qualify as a finisher, a rider must complete 75% of the winner's number of laps, whether taking the flag or not. Where the total number of laps is not divisible by 4, the number of laps required to qualify will be rounded down to the nearest whole number. (See also MXRR 21)

GATE PICK

Your gate pick for both heats will be determined by your qualifying position.

SCORING - INTERPROVINCIAL

Points will be allocated in terms of the following scoring system, i.e. $1^{st} - 40$, $2^{nd} - 39$, $3^{rd} - 38$, $4^{th} - 37$, etc

SCORING - NORTH vs SOUTH

Points will be allocated to the first 10 riders: $1^{st} - 10$, $2^{nd} - 9$, $3^{rd} - 8$, etc

SCORING - INDIVIDUAL

Points will be allocated in terms of the current scoring system, i.e. $1^{st} - 35$, $2^{nd} - 32$, $3^{rd} - 30$, $4^{th} - 29$, etc

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 riders per class. Medals will be awarded to all junior finishers.

Refer to WOMZA 2018 MXRRs for all other race details.
