CLOSURE OF CIRCUIT:

Organisers and Clubs must close circuits on: **18th February 2019**. The responsibility for establishing if a circuit is open lies with the competitor.

The Flat Track Course shall, unless authorised by WOMZA, be between 1,2km and maximum 1,8km in length. For the 50cc / Junior circuits minimum length is 1,2km and maximum 1,8km in length.

ENTRY TO CIRCUIT:

Entrance to the grounds will be free for a (1) rider and (1) mechanic, all other persons will have to pay an entry fee at the entrance to the venue, as decided on by the organising club.

Spectators and parents will not be allowed on the circuit. Designated, fenced areas created for this purpose must be used. During 50cc, 65cc and 85cc races, dedicated officials will be allowed on the track.

Combining and separating of classes on the day shall be at the discretion of the COC, in conjunction with the jury, with safety being the foremost priority.

CLASSES AND ELLIGIBILITY – COMPETITORS

- MX50cc JNR** - (Water-cooled Motorcycles not exceeding 52cc)
Age – 4-7 years. Rear 10” Wheel maximum and 12” front wheel maximum.
- MX50cc SNR** - (Water cooled Motorcycles not exceeding 52cc)
Aged 7 – 9 years of age. Rear 10 “ when maximum and 12” front wheel maximum.
- MX 65cc** - (Motorcycles not exceeding 65cc)
Age – 7 to 12 years. Wheel diameter not to exceed 14” front and 12” rear.
- MX 85cc** - (Clutch Lever – motorcycles not exceeding 85cc 2 stroke)
Age – 8 to 15 years. Wheel diameter not to exceed 17” rear and 19” front.
Will be bore and stroke to capacity only and no further restrictions will apply.

Motorcycles not exceeding 150cc 4 stroke or 85cc 2 stroke. Minimum wheel size minimum 17" and 19" front wheel.

- MX 125 (High school)** Two stroke motorcycles not exceeding 126cc.
Minimum wheel size 18" rear and 21" front Competitors of 13 to 19 years of age.
- MX2** Motorcycles not exceeding 250cc four-stroke or 150cc 2 stroke Minimum wheel size 18" rear and 21" front.
- MX1** Motorcycles not exceeding 300cc 2 stroke and 450cc 4 stroke. Minimum wheel size 18" rear and 21" front.
Competitors of 15 years of age and older.
- MX3 Vets** Motorcycles of unrestricted capacity. Minimum wheel size 18" rear and 21" front.
Competitors of 30 - 38 years of age
- MX 3 Masters** Motorcycles of unrestricted capacity. Minimum wheel size 18" rear and 21" front.
Competitors of 38+ years of age
- MX3 Ladies** Competitors of a minimum age of 13 years old can compete on Motorcycles not exceeding 85cc or 150cc.
Competitors of a minimum age of 14 years old can compete on Motorcycles not exceeding 125cc
Competitors of a minimum age of 15 years old can compete on Motorcycles with a capacity not exceeding a 250cc 4 stroke
Competitors of a minimum age of 16 years old can compete on Motorcycles with a capacity not exceeding a 250cc 2 stroke.
Competitors of a minimum age of 18 year old can compete on Motorcycles with a capacity not exceeding 450cc 4 stroke or 300cc 2 stroke.
- Quad - Sportsman** (Nerf bars and Kill switch) - 12 years and older. Minimum 200cc 2T - Maximum 300cc 2T, minimum 4T - maximum 400cc 4T.
- Quad - Open** (Nerf bars and kill switch) - 16 years and older. Minimum 350cc 2T - Maximum 405cc 4T.
