

## Session 3: Scriptural and Other References

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In Session Three of our seminar in Biblical Typology we referred to a number of Scriptural passages as well several non-Biblical texts. I include these references here in the order in which they appeared in the seminar.

- † All things through Jesus, the creative Word of God: *Colossians 1:16-17*
- † In the beginning was the Word: *John 1:1*
- † Jesus' mission, to make God known: *John 1:14-18*
- † The Son reveals knowledge of the Father: *St. Irenaeus, Against the Heresies*
- † The Word appears to Abraham at Mamre: *Genesis 18:1*
- † Jacob – “I have seen God face to face”: *Genesis 32:30*
- † God is doing a “new thing”: *Isaiah 43:16,18-19*
- † A voice crying out in the desert: *Isaiah 40:3; John 1:23*
- † Exodus and return from exile: *Jeremiah 23:7-8*
- † A New Covenant prophesied and realized: *Jeremiah 31:31-33; Luke 22:20*
- † “Out of Egypt I have called my Son”: *Hosea 11:1; Matthew 2:15*
- † 40 years in the wilderness as type of Jesus in the desert: *Exodus 17:1; Deuteronomy 6:16; 8:2-4; Psalm 91:11-12; Matthew 2:15; 3:3; 4:1-3*
- † “I desire mercy. Not sacrifice”: *Hosea 6:6; Matthew 9:13*
- † The blind see, the lame walk...: *Isaiah 35:5; 61:1; Matthew 11:4-6*
- † Living water, bread from heaven: *Isaiah 44:3; Nehemiah 9:15; John 6*
- † Jesus, “the Prophet” of Moses: *Deuteronomy 18:15-19; Acts 3:22-24*
- † Moses & Jesus – two infants saved: *Exodus 1:22; Matthew 2:13-14*
- † Moses & Jesus – their youth in Egypt: *Exodus 1-2; Matthew 2:14*
- † Moses & Jesus – both left Egypt for the Promised Land: *Exodus 13:17; Matthew 2:19-23*
- † Moses & Jesus – both fasted in the wilderness for 40 days: *Exodus 34:28; Matthew 4:1-2*
- † Moses & Jesus – both chose 12: *Deuteronomy 1:16; Luke 6:12-16*
- † Moses & Jesus – both proclaim the Law: *Exodus 19-20; Matthew 5-7*
- † Not to abolish the Law but to fulfill: *Matthew 5:17*
- † Grace and Truth through Jesus Christ: *John 1:17*

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- † Moses & Jesus – water, wine and blood: *Exodus 7:14-25; John 2:7-9; Luke 20:22*
- † Moses & Jesus – leading God’s people out of slavery: *Exodus 14; John 8:34-36*
- † Moses – raising the bronze serpent as type of Jesus and the Cross: *Numbers 21:6-9; John 3:14*
- † Moses – raising arms as type of the Cross: *St. Cyprian, Treatises; Exodus 17:8-16;*
- † Moses – throwing wood in the waters of Marah as a type of the healing power of the Cross: *Exodus 15:25*
- † Moses – the 12 fountains and 70 palm trees at Elim as types of the apostles and disciples: *Exodus 15:27*
- † Jesus and the Mosaic Law, Jesus writes with His finger: *Exodus 31:18; Jeremiah 13:31; John 8:1-11*
- † Jesus & Moses – faces shone like the sun: *Exodus 34:29; Matthew 17:2*
- † Transfiguration – God’s praise of His Son: *Matthew 17:4; Isaiah 42:1*
- † Children of Abraham: *John 8:39*
- † Jacob renamed “Israel”: *Gen 32:29*
- † The servitude of Jesus: *Philippians 2:7; Matthew 20:28*
- † Jesus refers to Jacob's Ladder: *Genesis 28:10-19; John 1:51*
- † Many titles of Jesus Christ, including “Jacob” and “Israel”: *St. Justin, Dialogues with Trypho*
- † The faith of the Patriarchs: *Hebrews 11:8-22*
- † Abraham’s “sacrifice” of Isaac: *Genesis 22; Prayers of Rosh Hashanah*
- † Isaac & Jesus – He did not spare his only son: *Genesis 22:16; Romans 8:32*
- † Job – the hard life of a man in earth: *Job 7:1*
- † Job commentary – *St. Gregory the Great, Morals on Job*
- † Job – God to Eliphaz: *Job 42:7*
- † Job – the spirit of prophecy: *Job 9:17-24*
- † Job – the gifts of prophecy: *St. Gregory, Morals on Job*
- † Job foresees the Redeemer and the resurrection: *Job 19:25-26*
- † Bearing each other’s burdens: *Galatians 6:2-3*
