Through the day, Karlee will teach you the in's and out's of Graffiti Quilting, how to recognize and draw various motifs, how to pair them together, and how to construct your very own unique Graffiti Quilt from start to finish! Class is constructed of equal parts drawing and free-motion quilting. The key to any good Graffiti Quilt is knowing how to draw each motif on paper. So come and join us for a full day jam-packed with all things Graffiti Quilting!



Here is what you'll need:

- A sewing machine that allows Free-motion quilting
- A sketchbook and pen
- A 20" x 20" basted quilt sandwich (black backing, white top and 2 layers of 80/20 or similar batting in-between)
- 3 to 4 few bright colors of thread, 40 wt is preferred, with a bobbin of each thread to match
- A Fabric marking tool (chalk, marker, dealers choice)
- A pair of scissors for trimming threads (I like mini scissors that I can attach to my shirt, bring whatever you fancy)

Please select if you want to bring your own machine with free motion quilting capabilities **or reserve one provided by Dave's Bernina of Provo, UT. Sew Simply Stitched will coordinate your reservation, based on first come, first served basis.

(Dave's Bernina will be providing a Bernina Q20 sit down long arm machine or a 700 series machine. Each machine will be a shared among two students.)
