PLAYER'S WAIVER, CONSENT AND CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Warranty of Player's Fitness

The undersigned (hereinafter, "the Player" or legal guardian of "the Player") hereby informs and warrants to Westchase Express Inc. and the League Committee, (hereinafter, "Governing Body"), the Houston Collegiate Summer League (hereinafter, "HCSL" or "League"), and all league approved playing and practice facilities (hereinafter, "Facilities") that the Player is in good physical condition and that he/she has no impairment(s), injuries, and/or ailment(s) preventing or endangering him/her while participating in League activities. _____ (Initial)

Player's Liability & Compliance Consent

The Player consents to full disclosure of violations or legal infractions that may bring discredit and/or harm to the Governing Body, the HCSL and/or its Facilities. Violations include and are not limited to alcohol, drug or paraphernalia possession or dispersion, armed or unarmed violence, child abuse, and or sexual assault. Because the League and its Governing Body values out Facilities along with our sponsors' reputations and images, it is the responsibility of the Governing Body to maintain a positive community image. Any player violating this consent will be terminated immediately without retribution or refund. _____ (Initial)

The Player consents to the appropriate usage of pictures and videos of games, players, and activities to promote the HCSL and its mission. No player shall receive monetary payment directly for services or usage of pictures. The HCSL shall not use player's names for promotions or revenue generation. Collegiate eligible players shall be responsible for their own review of liability and collegiate compliance with NCAA, NJCAA, NAIA, or other rules governing amateur status. This shall mean, that the HCSL suggests that each collegiate eligible player runs this agreement through their own respective school's compliance coordinators to ensure compliance. _____ (Initial)

The HCSL and its Governing Body has already submitted copies of this agreement to the NCAA and NAIA Eligibility centers for comments and compliance. The HCSL and its Governing Body however, shall not take responsibility of any compliance responsibilities above and beyond that which is outlined herein, and for which the player and/or school shall have already been granted sufficient time to review and concur. _____ (Initial)

Player's Personal Code of Conduct Commitment Agreement

The Player agrees to the following rules and commitments as proposed by the HCSL and its Governing Body.

- The Player upon agreement shall at all time adhere to the HCSL Code of Conduct along with all outlined core values as posted and described on this agreement and as outline on the www.HCSLeague.com website. A formal copy of this consent form shall be included in the Player Package. _____ (Initial)

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- The Player shall commit to his/her fellow program members, of all ages, and will work to help with communicating and ensuring teammates get to the games and practices, as needed. Forms of assistance may range from calling to remind players of show times to assisting fellow players with rides to and from games accordingly. _____ (Initial)
- The Player agrees and is solely committed to their HCSL assigned team as assigned, and shall not play or participate in other program activities without the prior approval of their Coaching Staff. Pitchers may not pitch outside of their scheduled throwing programs. This shall include showcases, professional organizational open workouts, or college workouts without prior approval of their respective team's Coaching Staff. This is to protect and allow for appropriate rest of our league members. Violations may result in a 4 game suspension. _____ (Initial)
- The Player shall work to help improve the team by providing constructive criticism and lead by example. Any negative attitudes or selfish behavior shall result in a 2 game suspension. _____ (Initial)
- The Player shall understand and accept the role explained by their Coaching Staff and understand that there is no guaranteed playing time. Playing time will be a result of 1. Performance, 2. Situation, 3. Strategy, 4. Preparation and 5. Balance of Time. _____ (Initial)

No Player is more important than the other, whether you start or are a substitute. Therefore each player shall be held to a standard of dignity and respect for one another and work to improve his/her teammates to the best of his/her abilities. Everyone wants to win and nobody wants to lose so remember this when each of us makes a mistake. Remember no one here is perfect or makes every play every time.

Violation of the Player's Code of Conduct Commitment Agreement

Violation of the player's code of behavior, rules and commitment agreement will be enforced by their team's coaching staff and/or manager. The Player will understand and guarantee adherence to any decision by their team's Coaching Staff shall be final. _____ (Initial)

Player may appeal a termination, within 5 days from being notified, with a written explanation and remorse for a violation directly to the Governing Body. The Governing Body shall provide an answer within 3 business days of receiving an official appeal request. ____ (Initial)

Incidents of severe punishment may result in permanent dismissal from the team at which time only transportation and lodging costs may be reimbursed for tournaments not attended, if paid separately. The HCSL and its Governing Body may reserve the right to request any parts of the uniforms back in the case where the uniforms are not paid as part of the fee. _____ (Initial)

Absolute Release of Liability

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the activities with the HCSL, in any manner, including but not limited to playing, practicing, coaching, observing (as a spectator) or being on the field or in the spectator areas for any purpose whatsoever, and fully understanding that participation in the game of baseball includes the risk of serious personal injury, the undersigned Player (and/or Legal Guardian) fully and absolutely assumes full responsibility for the risk of injury due to participation, weather conditions, playing conditions (including the type of bases, plates, fences, and equipment) other participants, of any magnitude including fatality, and does hereby forever absolutely release, even for their own negligence, and agrees to hold harmless the Governing Body, the HCSL and the Facilities which shall include all government

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bodies and landowners that may sanction or permit the participation in the game of baseball and all employees, other participants, agents, servants, officers, public officials, volunteers, game officials, and sponsors from all claims for damages whatsoever of any kind now or in the future.

Limitation of Liability

The Player shall participate in the HCSL programs, games, and travel without limitation to facilities, services, or equipment at the player's own risk. _____ (Initial)

The Player waives any and all claims, of whatsoever kind or nature that may arise against the Governing Body, League or its Facilities as a result of the Player's participation in the HCSL game(s) and/or tournament(s). _____ (Initial)

The Collegiate Player realizes that there is "NO GUARANTEED" playing time. _____ (Initial)

The player also acknowledges recognition of the team, league and inherent rules of the game of baseball and any deviation of such rules like the "helmet rule" (the rule being that all batters and base runners must wear helmets at all times) shall be at his own risk. _____ (Initial)

The Player also acknowledges recognition of the fact that only liability and catastrophic insurance is inherent with the program membership fee during team sanctioned events. Medical insurance may be made available through various events as part of the registration and participation requirements and will be valid only for that said event. _____ (Initial)

Release and Agreement Signature

I, the Player (and/or Legal Guardian), have read this release and understand that it is an absolute release and freely and voluntarily accept its terms and understand it is binding upon me, my heirs, spouse in interest and assigns.

I, the undersigned player, hereby agree to play baseball with the assigned HCSL team for the ____ summer season. I understand that this agreement will remain in force throughout the ____ collegiate summer season and may be invalidated only by the League directors and their team's coaching staff.

By signing this document I agree to participate in other non-league teams, sanctioned or otherwise, only to the extent allowed by team's coaches and League rules.

I understand that this contract is a direct offer of the League to fill a place on a roster in accordance with League regulations, and that failure to sign this agreement by the required date may be cause for the team to remove me from the roster.

I understand that I may be released from this agreement only in the event of my signing a professional contract; being selected to an active traveling all-star team sanctioned by or sponsored by the NCAA, the U.S. Olympic Committee or any of its subordinate committees, or a similar amateur athletics authority; or by written mutual consent of the commissioner of both involved leagues.

When leaving the team I am aware that I must return to team or league representatives all equipment and uniforms issued to me during the season that were not purchased by myself or my parents/guardians.

By signing this agreement, I certify that I will not use any form of tobacco during practice sessions or contests. And I have read and agreed to the HCSL Player Code of Conduct & Liability Waiver Agreement.

I understand that this contract is not valid until each of the requested signatures is obtained. Intending to be legally bound hereby, I have signed this agreement.
