ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Phase 4 Residential Sewer Connections** will be received by the **Owner, Buckskin Sanitary District** at their office located at 8832 Riverside Drive, Suite 4, Parker, AZ 85344 until **2:00 P.M.** local time on **March 12, 2019** at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment for the construction of new residential sewer connections including all work, and all miscellaneous equipment and modifications, shown or specified, necessary to provide a complete and operable system.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

The ISSUING OFFICE for the Bidding Documents is: Buckskin Sanitary District, 8832 Riverside Drive, Suite 4, Parker, AZ 85344.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents on Mondays through Thursdays between the hours of **9-12 noon, and 1-5 pm.**, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

The project specifications and other proposal documents and contract documents are now on file at the District office (8832 Riverside Drive, Suite #4, Parker, Arizona 85344), where they may be examined. Contract Documents may be downloaded from the District's web site @ [www.bsdsewer.org](http://www.bsdsewer.org). **Go to Phase 4 Residential Bid Documents**. Additional reports and documents identified in the Supplementary Conditions and not part of the Contract Documents may also be downloaded from the District's web site.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, **February 26, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.** at the LaPaz County Boat Safety Building located at 8484 Riverside Drive, Parker, Arizona. A tour of the project area will follow.

Those submitting proposals must be eligible to do the Work under and in accordance with, and must agree to conform to, the laws of the State of Arizona. No preference described in Title 34 of Arizona Revised Statutes applies to the Contract.

Each proposal shall be sealed in an envelope addressed to the District Manager of the Buckskin Sanitary District of La Paz County, Arizona, and bear the following statement on the outside of the envelope: **Proposal to Construct Contract 103 - Phase 4 Residential Sewer Connections, Buckskin Sanitary District of La Paz County, Arizona.**

Each proposal shall be made out in the form set forth in the Contract Documents and all pages of said Contract Documents book must be submitted as part of the proposal and shall be accompanied by a bid bond payable to the Buckskin Sanitary District of La Paz County, Arizona for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid. The above-mentioned bond shall be given as a guarantee that the entity submitting the related proposal will enter into the Contract if awarded to such entity and will be declared forfeited if the entity submitting the related proposals refuses to enter into the Contract after being requested to do so by the District Board of Directors.

All proposals shall be filed with the District Manager at the District Office, 8832 Riverside Drive, Suite #4, Parker, Arizona, 85344 on or before 2:00 p.m. local time, **March 12, 2019**. All proposals will be opened at an

open meeting to be held on such date. Thereafter, all proposals will be tabulated by the District Manager who shall report his findings to the Board of Directors. The proposals will be examined and publicly declared at a public meeting of the Board of Directors to be held by the District on **March 19, 2019**. It is expected that the Board of Directors will award the Contract to the entity submitting the lowest cost, responsive proposal at such Board meeting to be held on or after **March 19, 2019**.

This project will be funded by the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Utility Services (“RUS”) and will therefore require that the Contractor strictly adhere to the federal requirements governing said work.

The Board of Directors reserve the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the proposals.
