At SRCA we take teaching/learning very seriously and we believe that the way a student dresses will directly impact their attitude toward learning. Therefore, we ask both parents and students to adopt a cooperative attitude in adhering not only to the letter, but also the spirit of our policies on dress. Students are required to wear a uniform every day, unless specific instructions are given. Uniforms may be purchased at local department stores but ALL TOPS MUST BE MONOGRAMMED WITH THE SRCA LOGO. Changes have been made to the school logo. All new shirts must have the new monogram. However, students are still allowed to wear uniforms with the round eagle logo that has been used in the past.

- Our school dress code for uniforms applies to grades PreK-8th.
- Monogramming will ONLY be available through two options:
 - o Uniform tops may be ordered at local department stores and given to Posh Boutique to monogram (See next page for detailed instructions).
 - o Or, monogrammed uniform tops may be purchased through landsend.com.

Guidelines are as follows:

BOYS

Tops

- Uniform tops must be collared/polo in style.
 Shirt colors include white, navy blue, Kelley or hunter green with school logo.
- Shirts must be tucked in with a belt at all times (1st-8th only).
- School Tees will be allowed on Fridays only.

Bottoms

- Navy and khaki uniform shorts or pants may be worn.
- This does **NOT** include athletic shorts.

Shoes

- All shoes must be closed toe and closed heel.
 Flip flops and sandals are not allowed.
- Boots and tennis shoes must be conservative in style.

Outerwear

 All outerwear (including jackets, pull-over fleece, and sweatshirts) must be <u>SOLID</u> SRCA colors (navy blue or Kelley green). Items can be purchased at the place of your choice but <u>MUST</u> have a SRCA school logo.

GIRLS

Tops

- Uniform tops must be collared/polo in style. Shirt colors include white, navy blue, Kelley or hunter green with school logo.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times (1st-8th grade only).
- <u>School Tees will be allowed</u> on Fridays only.

Bottoms

- Choices for bottoms include NAVY AND KHAKI:
 - Shorts (no athletic shorts), skorts, jumpers/dresses or uniform style slacks.
- Length of bottoms **MUST** be no shorter than two-three inches above the knee.
- Leggings/skinny pants are NOT considered uniform bottoms and are NOT ALLOWED.
- Athletic shorts worn during sporting events must extend to the tips of the student's fingers.

Shoes

- All shoes must be closed toe and closed heel.
 Flip flops and sandals are not allowed. Girls may also wear saddle shoes or Mary Jane shoes.
- Boots and tennis shoes must be conservative in style. Sequin, glitter, or rhinestone detailed shoes are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Outerwear

 All outerwear (including jackets, pull-over fleece, and sweatshirts) must be <u>SOLID</u> SRCA colors (navy blue or Kelley green). Items can be purchased at the place of your choice but <u>MUST</u> have a SRCA school logo.

OUT OF DRESS-CODE GUIDELINES

Personal attire should remain modest.

- No tight or form-fitting clothing should be worn.
- Shirts need to be tucked inside the pants, and be of a length as to stay tucked in.
- Bottoms must be no shorter than three inches above the knee.
- Leggings may only be worn **ONLY if accompanying tops extend to the** mid-thigh.
- No midriff should be showing.
- Open-toe shoes are not allowed.
- No inappropriate slogans or pictures shall be permitted on any clothing.

General Appearance

- Girls may wear only one earring in the lobe of each ear.
- Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.
- Excessive makeup and jewelry is not allowed. Boys are not allowed to wear makeup.
- No artificial or extremely contrasted hair coloring contrary to natural hair color is allowed.
- Girls' hair must be kept out of the eyes.
- Boys' hair is to be worn off the collar, the eyebrows, and off the ears.
- No body piercing is allowed.
- No Tattoos (temporary or permanent) are acceptable.

The administration reserves the right to ask students to refrain from wearing items that have developed inappropriate meanings or are distracting in nature.

DIRECTIONS FOR ORDERING MONOGRAMS THROUGH POSH BOUTIQUE ON ETSY.COM

Monogramming MUST FIRST be purchased through Posh Boutique at etsy.com. The link for this online shop is located on the school's website (www.srcajesup.org) under the admissions tab.

When purchasing monograms online, make sure to note under "note to seller" how many of each color and size (blue, green, or white) is being monogrammed. (Ex: 2 small blue, 1 large green, etc.)

After purchasing the correct number of monograms, please print off the purchase invoice that is sent to your email.

Uniform tops, as well as the purchase invoice, should be brought to the school <u>on one of the drop off dates listed below.</u>

At checkout, if you do not wish to pay the automatic shipping fee and plan to pick up your order at the school on one of the dates listed below, then enter "SOLIDROCK" in the coupon code box. Having the items shipped to you is an option, but shipping charges will be added to your total cost.
