Preliminary Dog Adoption

Thank you for your interest in adopting one of our NAWS pets!

There are times we believe that it is in the best interest of both the pet and the adopter to have a trial period at a home to be sure that the match is a good one. Below is the Preliminary Adoption Plan:

1. Adopter will fill out an Adoption Application and provide it with the adoption fee, and attached to this form.

2. Adopter will take pet(s) home (provided all necessary vetting has been completed first) for a 1-2 week trial period, or whatever is agreed upon by the Dog Adoption Program Manager.

3. If the match is not found to be a good one, either by the Adopter or by the Dog Adoption Program Manager, NAWS will refund the full adoption fee within the trial period.

4. If the match is found to be good – the Dog Adoption Program Manager will arrange a day/time to meet with the Adopter to finalize the adoption paperwork.

5. Adoption paperwork contains – Adoption Contract, Vetting History, Microchip Information, Alumni Club Information, and other miscellaneous items.

PLEASE NOTE! We will try to the best of our ability to disclose any behavioral issues with the pet(s), but we have no way of knowing for certain of the dog's temperament in your home environment and you are assuming all risk.
