

# TRACKING IN SNOW AND MUD



## Deer

When deers are moving fast the . You may also spot deer tacks as just the front hoof.



## Dog

Mostly dog track (or coyote) have clear nail markings.



## Raccoon

Toes are slightly splayed in front; 5 front and back; usually see claws.



## Cat

Tracks have 4 toes; usually in a zigzag shape; usually no nails.



## Rabbit

Longer hind feet and smaller front foot shapes; usually square pattern, for bounding or hopping.



## Squirrel

Usually can see boney toes; 5 hind toes; 4 front. Squirrels bound or hop while moving; back feet look to be in front.
