After he died and the fog settled a little, we heard stories about how our daughters fared at the hospital. I am confident my girls only felt love and comfort during their time in the hospital, and you were a part of that story. They still sleep with their blanket and stuffed animals; one of our daughters even brought the cat to show and tell because she formed an attachment to it. The items also serve as a reminder of our sweet baby and of God's provision and sovereignty. I hope many more will be encouraged and blessed by your work”.
