**Classic Car Rally** was very successful at our new venue, the events field at Cornish Market World. We had 100 classic vehicles

**Par Bay Fish Fayre** - Considering the fact that it was organised at very short notice by a collaboration between us and Friends of Par Beach along with Felicity Sylvester of Par Bay Sustainable Fish Project, it went reasonably well, in the old play area, on Par Beach.
