Welcome to Guests

GB welcomed guests. Introductions around the table.

Guest Speakers

JS spoke about the need to inspire young people. She deals with young Beach Rangers. She spoke about Employment Skills and the need to embed Best Practice now rather than later. As examples, **GB** spoke about her visits to Tywardreath School recently, engaging pupils in Community and Marine and Beach Plastics Pollution. On these visits she was accompanied by SH (Community) and JP (Plastics). GB also coordinated a visit to Par Beach by Polruan School (Plastics, Nature Reserve and Mini beach litter pick) with JP and school staff. A general discussion followed. **JS** said she would like to run an event in late summer, focussed on young people.

TE spoke of the need to engage the youth of the area in the local Neighbourhood Plans and, as the Plan will primarily affect young people, to encourage them to put forward ideas for questions on the main public questionnaire. Good idea to 'piggy back' groups on the NP. Give prizes for ideas. There was then more general discussion.
