Shondrae Crawford (his [stage names](#) **Bangladesh** and **Mr. Bangladesh**. his first big break production of the hit single, "[What's Your Fantasy](#)" for [Ludacris](#). He worked with [Lil Wayne](#), producing one of his most successful singles, "[A Milli](#)." He also produced the beat behind [Gucci Mane](#)'s song [Lemonade](#), including [Yelawolf](#), [Curren\\$y](#), [Tyler, the Creator](#) with [Earl Sweatshirt](#), and [Big Sean](#).^[5] He also produced Wayne's hit 2011 song "[6 Foot 7 Foot](#)", featuring [Cory Gunz](#), and he has produced for [Beyoncé](#), [Nicki Minaj](#), [Ludacris](#), [Syleena Johnson](#), [Ke\\$ha](#), [Usher](#), [T-Pain](#), [Bad Meets Evil](#), [Ice Cube](#), and many other artists. Bangladesh collaborated with [Bajan](#) singer [Rihanna](#) on [Talk that Talk](#) for the song [Cockiness \(Love It\)](#).

DJ JELLY IS A key factor in breaking local Atlanta artists such as OutKast, Lil Jon, T.I, Jeezy, Dj UNK, Travis Porter, Wakafloka, to humbly name a few.Co-founding "BIG OOMP RECORDS". Dj Jelly's live mixes can be heard during the popular 9'oclock mixtape on CBS radio's number one station, Atlanta's, V103.

Organized Noize; Organized Noise is an [Atlanta](#)-based [American hip hop production](#) company made up of Rico Wade, Ray Murray and [Sleepy Brown](#).¹

Among the hit records they have worked on include [TLC](#)'s "[Waterfalls](#)", [En Vogue](#)'s "[Don't Let Go \(Love\)](#)", and [Ludacris](#)' "[Saturday \(Oooh Oooh\)](#)". They are most notable for producing a large amount of material for [OutKast](#) (including all of [Southernplayalisticadillacmuzik](#) and "So Fresh, So Clean" from [Stankonia](#)) and [Goodie Mob](#) (including all of [Soul Food](#) and "They Don't Dance No Mo" from [Still Standing](#)). Both groups are part of Organized Noize's [Dungeon Family](#) collective, which also includes [Slimm Cutta Calhoun](#) and [Joi](#), among others.

They also contributed on the soundtrack of the 1996 critically acclaimed heist film [Set It Off](#). In 2006, they contributed additional music to the film [Miami Vice](#). In 2010 they produced several songs on the critically acclaimed Island/Def Jam solo debut from [Big Boi](#) titled [Sir Lucious Left Foot: The Son of Chico Dusty](#). In 2011, they produced the entire album "Nappy Dot Org" for [Nappy Roots](#).^[2]

On February 8, 2016 it was announced that on March 22, 2016 the documentary "The Art of Organized Noize" will premiere on [Netflix](#)

Xavier Dotson, better known as Zaytoven: Zaytoven is an American disk jockey and record producer born in Germany. He has worked with [Gucci Mane](#) extensively, contributing at least one song on every one of his albums, [Soulja Boy Tell 'Em](#), [Gorilla Zoe](#), [Young Jeezy](#), [OJ Da Juiceman](#), [Future](#), [Doe B](#), [Usher](#), [Migos](#) (for their [Hot 100](#) hit "[Versace](#)"), and other non-Atlanta artists such as [Nicki Minaj](#), producing hundreds of songs in total. He won a [Grammy Award](#) in 2011 for his contribution to Usher's [Raymond vs. Raymond](#) album, as a co-producer and writer for the single "[Papers](#)" along with [Sean Garrett](#)
