Born and raised in Fresno, I went to college at Cal State Fresno, 2 miles from my

State Queen-elect Lynn Sanders Fresno, 2 miles from my home. In 1974 I joined Xerox Corporation doing clerical work, but soon I was recruited to learn copier service, a big promotion. I'm very grateful to Xerox for the opportunities that were provided and the secure retirement I now enjoy.

In 1987 I discovered ballroom dancing and NSD at Fresno's coronation and I was immediately hooked. I applied for membership and became active in chapter activities and lessons. I entered showcases and dance competitions any time a partner was available, which was not nearly as often as I would have liked. Thank you to David Hailpern and Hartune Neffian for competing with me in my first few nerve-wracking competitions.

In 1991 I transferred with Xerox to the SF Bay area near San Jose where my mother, my sister and her children lived. I supposedly made the move for advancement at Xerox, but my secret reason was to pursue dance competition opportunities. I continued to participate in Fresno chapter events and activities as much as I could.

I joined USA Dance NorCal, the local ballroom dance competition association, became a board member and

competitor, and met my dance partner to be and now long-time friend, Dr. James Kleinrath. We competed in dance competition until 1997, winning many Smooth and Standard events and



top solo awards. I have never been able to "kick the addiction" to dancing and have continued to be an active social dancer, dabbling occasionally with competition when the opportunity and inclination coincided.

In 2006, I accepted an early retirement offer from Xerox after 32 years and then worked for the San Jose Police Dept. until retiring for good in August 2017. Now in full retirement, dancing will no longer be interrupted by an inconvenient work schedule.

For my coronation this September, I will, again, be escorted by my former partner, James. I am so grateful to him for the dancing we shared and his continuing friendship and support.

I am very proud to be celebrating my 31st anniversary as a Fresno Smooth Dancer in November this year. So much of what is meaningful in my life started at that first NSD Coronation. The true love of my life has been sharing the joy of ballroom dancing with dear friends in Fresno and all over California. I'm so looking forward to visiting each chapter now as State Queen, renewing friendships and making new friends as we celebrate the lovely Smooth Dancer traditions of Queens and Coronations.





Ecuador. One of the highlights was to see a demonstration of how water spirals down a sink. When moved from one side of the equator, it would drain clockwise and to the other side, it would drain counter-clockwise.

The marine iguanas are used to people being around while enjoying themselves in the sun. It is hard to spot them at first glance, since they are camouflaged with the lava, that you really need to pay attention to where you were walking. The

Galapagos Islands are comprised of many volcanos, and two days after visiting Isabella Island, we heard that there was an earthquake which started a lava flow. You can see some video online, which looks like the Hawaii lava flow, only there are no villages in the path of the lava flow in the Galapagos.



After a wonderful time in the Galapagos, 26 of the 100 people on the ship went on to Peru to visit Machu Picchu. The trip to Machu Picchu was an adventure because of the high altitude. We rode a train from our hotel, followed

by a bus ride up a winding road. Inside Machu Picchu, the climbs were done in small stages to make sure we had time to catch our breath and take lots of pictures. It was a wonderful trip with great weather. We have lots of fun memories and beautiful pictures to help remember our trip.




