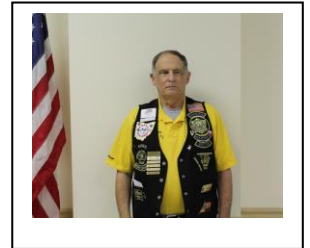

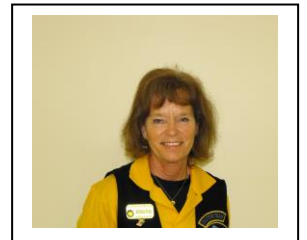

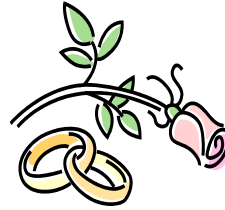
Then in December, we showed up in force to help with the Christmas Kick Off and lighting of the community tree, it was beautiful.
