



Notes from Tom Eden

Many of you are aware that I had some health challenges last year. As a result I have added an assortment of prescriptions to my daily routine. I was putting my new "Gold Book" with the items I normally carry on the bike. One of the items is my first aid kit and the other is the GWRRA N12 form. Several items in the first aid kit needed to be replaced and replenished. The N12 needed to be updated for my current situation. I have included a copy of the GWRRA N12 form to the newsletter as a suggestion to all that before we get into riding season, we review and update our personal medical information as needed. The GWRRA N12 is also available on the GWRRA National web site.

I have also included the Ohio BMV Form 2437, Notification of Next of Kin, which allows you to provide next of kin information which will be filed with your driver's license information making it readily available should you be involved in an accident. I picked up and filled out this form several years ago when I was renewing my driver's license.

I provide copies of both forms to all the people I have named as contacts. That way when they are contacted they can provide as much information as possible to whoever contacts them.
