Dear Interested Applicants:

This year the Solano County Farm Bureau Ag Education Foundation will be offering five scholarships, two at \$1,500 one at \$1,000 and two at \$500. The scholarships are open to all Solano County high school students that plan to enroll as a full-time student at a community college or University, **and/or** an undergraduate student whose hometown is in Solano County.

**Eligibility:** Eligibility to apply for the scholarship is based on the following:

- A. Student (family) must live in Solano County;
- B. Student must be a senior currently enrolled in a public or private high school in Solano County; or enrolled in any community college or university;
- C. Student should have an average to above-average academic record; and
- D. Students must be pursuing career and educational opportunities in agriculture or a related field of study.

Applicants will be evaluated on their high school records and/or college transcript grades, extracurricular activities, statement of purpose and completeness of application. All applications must be received – electronic submissions are allowed - Solano County Farm Bureau Ag Education Foundation, Attn: Lisa Shipley, 130 Allison Court. Ste. 2-A, Vacaville, CA 95688 or emailed to [solanofb@castles.com](mailto:solanofb@castles.com) on or before **5:00 PM, Friday April 30, 2021**. Applicants will be notified of the results sometime in May. Scholarships will be sent to the winners' school of record.
