We are excited about what God has done these past few months. In August, we enjoyed a wonderful church homecoming. It was great to reflect on what God has done through Shalom Baptist Church. In September, the bus company where I used to work was in need of help for the first month of school so I was able to substitute drive. This was a huge blessing for us as we were in need of some extra money for the van. The engine light had been on for awhile. I assumed it was only in need of a tune up; however, it was a little more complicated. Long story short, a friend of mine had a newer engine and transmission with only 40,000 miles on it. With his help and the generousity of another friend, we replaced our 114,000 mile motor and transmission for only about \$800. Now the van is running great and since the engine light is off, I was able to have the van inspection done right on time. What seemed like a bad situation, actually turned out to be a blessing in disguise as we expect to get many more miles out of the new motor. We are so thankful for friends who are willing to drop everything to help us out!

While driving the school bus, I had several opportunities to witness to some coworkers who were working as bus monitors.
