


## CASTLE ROCK: 5 miles, approx. 2 hours




**WHITE PELICAN LAUNCH POINT**

- Choose to go to left or right of islands, but always stay with the downstream current.
- At the bend (halfway mark) look for the eagle's nest at the top of the bluffs! ☺
- You're getting close (15 min or so) when you see a **residential area and a 2-lane highway** while on the wide stretch of river – time to **stay right!**
- At Castle Rock State Park, come ashore next to **the dock** that comes out in the river.
- Continuing on to the 4-hour trip? Last chance for water refill and bathrooms! (No facilities at Grand Detour)

## GRAND DETOUR: 12 miles, approx. 4 hours



**WHITE PELICAN SCENIC OVERLOOK**

**CASTLE ROCK STATE PARK**

**CANOE-IN CAMPGROUND ON RIGHT**

- Castle Rock is roughly halfway.
- Campers, *stay right*: canoe-in campground in approx. 30 min.
- Choose to explore left or right of islands
- You're getting close when you're on a 20-30 min. stretch of no islands.
- The next islands are THE CAMPING ISLANDS. **Stay left of Camping Islands** (right channel is blocked downstream!)
- **Immediately** after Camping Islands, go to right-hand shoreline. Take out is a stone! throw away from islands!
- Come ashore at a gravel turnaround lined by a **silver guardrail**. *Road bridge = too far! Turn around and paddle upstream, or stop and call!*

**TAKE OUT: ACROSS STREET FROM "JOHN DEERE HISTORIC SITE"**

**CAMPING ISLANDS: STAY TO THE LEFT, THEN GO IMMEDIATELY TO THE RIGHT SHORE.**
