

Section 5 - Expulsion or rejection

Members may be expelled or applicants may be rejected in a manner similar to the admission process if they are found to be engaging in behavior that is illegal, unethical or contrary to the club's bylaws and stated purpose.

Section 6 - Dues

The amount of the club's annual dues shall be determined by the Board of Directors, and shall be payable on or before the March meeting of each year. Discounts will be in effect if dues are paid at or before Open House, r to be decided by the Boar of Directors. Dues delinquent beyond the May meeting shall be cause for automatic dismissal of a member from the club, except in extenuating circumstances. Members thus dismissed must submit a new application for membership.

Section 7 - Renewal restriction for monies owed to the club

All monies owed to the club by members should be paid by the end of each calendar year and must be paid before members owing them can rejoin for the following year.

Section 8 - Honorary membership

An honorary non-voting membership may be granted by the Board of Directors free of charge to any non-riding immediate family member of a club member in good standing. Honorary members may not ride a horse at any Stonybrook show or club event.

ARTICLE IV - Government and Management

Section 1 - Administration of the club

The government and management of the club shall be vested in the Officers and Directors of the club.

Section 2 - Election of Officers

Officers shall be elected annually by a majority vote of at least 25% of the club's qualified voters who must be present at the regular November meeting. The officers elected at that time will take office on the first of January of the following year. Succession in the same office shall be limited to two (2) full years.

The Officers of the club shall be: President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary and Treasurer.

Section 3 - Election of Directors
