

CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS OF STONYBROOK SADDLE CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE I - Name of Organization

The name of the club shall be "Stonybrook Saddle Club, Inc."

ARTICLE II - Purpose of Organization

The purpose of the club shall be to promote horsemanship and sportsmanship in all activities related thereto, and to unite all those interested in enjoying a mutual fellowship among horse lovers.

ARTICLE III - Membership

Section 1 - Eligibility

Membership shall be open to anyone having a genuine interest in horses and in the welfare of the club.

Section 2 - Age classification

Members shall be classified as adult (19 and over) and have their own membership, juniors (11-18), or pee-wee (10 and under). All ages will be as of January 1st of each year.

Section 3 - Application for membership

A prospective member must present his application, with the current year's dues, to the membership committee.

Section 4 - Admission of new members

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Directors, admission will be decided by a secret majority vote of those present at the next regular meeting. The applicant will be notified by mail, by the secretary, of his acceptance or rejection. If rejected, his dues will be refunded.
