## STONYBROOK SADDLE CLUB, INC. RULES

**WARNING: YOU ASSUME THE RISK OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO PENNSYLVANIA LAW.**

- IF THERE ARE NOT AT LEAST THREE ENTRIES IN A CLASS, THE CLASS MAY BE CANCELLED.
- STONYBROOK SADDLE CLUB MAY ADD CLASSES TO SEPERATE WESTERN/ENGLISH CLASSES IF THERE ARE ENOUGH RIDERS IN THE CLASS.
- PEE WEE CLASSES ARE WALK/TROT ONLY. IF YOUR PEE WEE WOULD LIKE TO CANTER, HE/SHE CAN MOVE INTO THE JUNIOR DIVISION. PEEWEES CAN NOT ENTER OPEN CLASSES.
- ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR BOOTS, A SHIRT WITH SLEEVES (T-SHIRT), AND LONG PANTS.
- ALL RIDERS 18 YEARS AND UNDER ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPERLY FASTENED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHICH MEETS OR EXCEEDS CURRENT ASTM/SEI STANDARDS FOR EQUESTRIAN USE. HEADGEAR MUST BE PROPERLY FITTED AND IS REQUIRED WHILE RIDING OR DRIVING ANYWHERE ON THE EVENT GROUNDS.
- JUNIOR RIDERS MAY USE BUMPER SPURS BUT ARE NOT PERMITTED TO USE ROWELS.
- ABUSIVE AND UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- STONYBROOK SADDLE CLUB IS NOT AND WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INJURY, DAMAGE, OR LOSS TO EXHIBITORS, HORSES, PROPERTY, OR SPECTATORS. STONYBROOK MAINTAINS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE PARTICIPATION TO ANY HORSE DUE TO ILLNESS, INJURY, UNSOUNDNESS, OR UNCONTROLLABILITY.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS DURING COMPETITIONS AND CLINICS.
- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.
- **SPECTATORS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE PADDOCK AREA.**
- ONLY HORSES ENTERED IN THE CLASS IN PROGRESS ARE PERMITTED IN THE PADDOCK AREA. THE HOLDING AREA IS ONLY FOR CURRENT HORSE WAITING TO GO IN, HORSE ON DECK, AND HORSE IN THE HOLE.
- NO HORSES ARE PERMITTED TO STAND IN THE ALLEYWAY or DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF ENTRY BOOTH DURING A CLASS.
- HORSES MAY NOT BE TIED TO THE FENCES IN OR AROUND THE ALLEYWAY.
- DECISIONS OF THE JUDGE AND SHOW COMMITTEE ARE FINAL. ANY COMPLAINTS MUST BE FILED IN WRITING AT THE ENTRY BOOTH, **NOT WITH JUDGES.**
- ALL SICK, LAME, AND UNMANAGEABLE HORSES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE, RING MASTER, BOARD OF DIRECTORS, OR SHOW COMMITTEE. UNMANAGEABLE MAY BE DEFINED AS A HORSE RUNNING INTO A GATE DURING TIMED EVENTS OR RUNNING AWAY CAUSING RIDER TO BE BUCKED OFF, FALL, OR DISMOUNT. RIDER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THAT EVENT.
- ALL HORSES MUST BE UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES ON THE STONYBROOK SADDLE CLUB SHOW GROUNDS.
- NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN UNLESS A CLASS IS CANCELLED BY STONYBROOK OFFICIALS.
- HORSES BEING RIDDEN BETWEEN THE SHOW RING AND THE TRAILER AREA MUST BE KEPT AT A WALK. RUNNING OF HORSES IS ONLY PERMITTED IN THE RING AND IN DESIGNATED AREAS. RIDERS NOT FOLLOWING THIS RULE WILL BE INSTRUCTED TO DISMOUNT AND WALK THEIR HORSE OR TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS FOR THE DAY.
- NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 IS PERMITTED TO BRING, RIDE, OR HANDLE A STALLION.

I understand that by signing this show bill, I am agreeing to the rules of Stonybrook Saddle Club. I further understand that if I violate any of the aforementioned rules, I could be disqualified from any classes and asked to leave the show grounds for the day. I agree that all decisions made by the judges, show committee, or board members will be followed.

### YEAR END POINTS

(Members Only)

The points you earn today will count toward your end-of-year award. All classes are worth up to 5 points based on your placing. You receive 5 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 4 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 3 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> place, 2 points for 4<sup>th</sup> place, and 1 point for 5<sup>th</sup> place.

### RULES

- Divisions: Pee Wee (Riders Age 10 & under-Walk, Trot only), Junior (Riders Age 11 thru 17), Senior (Riders Age 18 & over), Novice ( based on horse's training level)
- Points will follow the horse and rider for the entire year. Riders will have to declare their division at the beginning of the year and will only be able to earn points toward their declared division.
- Riders who wish to show novice horses and non-novice horses will need to declare one division to earn points for the year-end awards. This does not stop them from showing multiple horses; however, they will not be able to earn points in both age division and novice division.
- Riders must attend shows, have sponsorships, and meet club's required work hours to qualify for year end awards.
