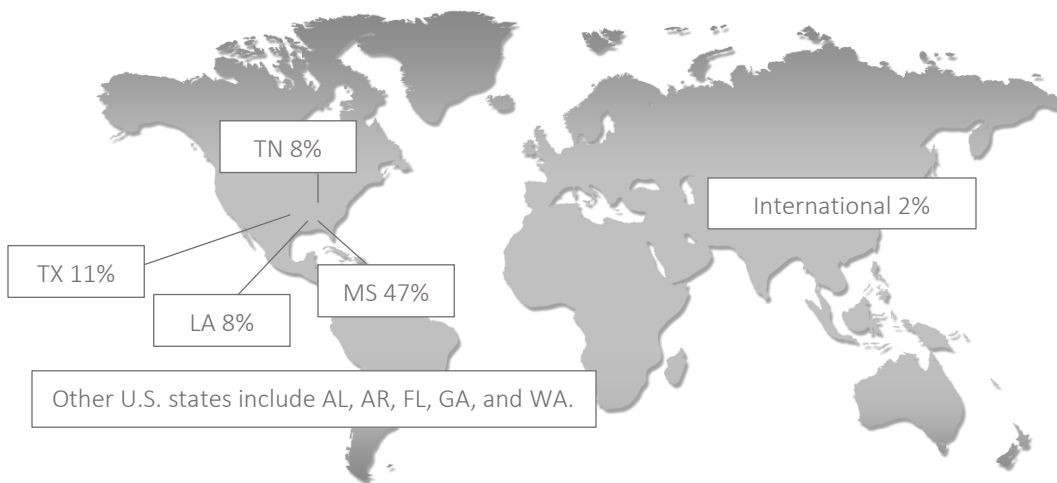


FIRST DESTINATION SURVEY RESULTS – CLASS OF 2016 – UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE

This first destination survey was administered to graduating students on May 9, 2016. 169 students responded regarding their career plans for graduate school, employment or both. Thus, the overall response rate was 99%.

90% reported that they are prepared for the next step in their careers. The average full-time salary for undergraduate and graduate students: \$42,223.

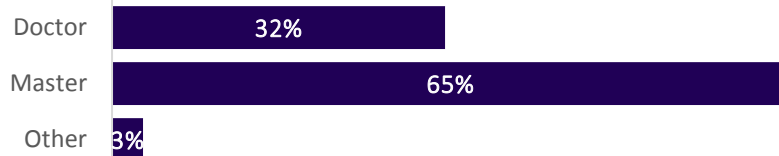

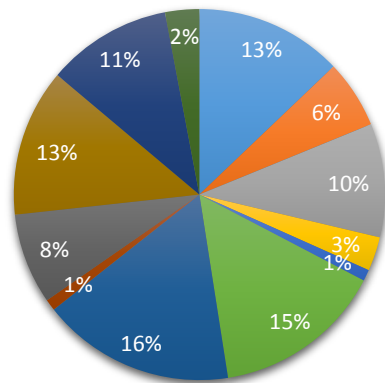

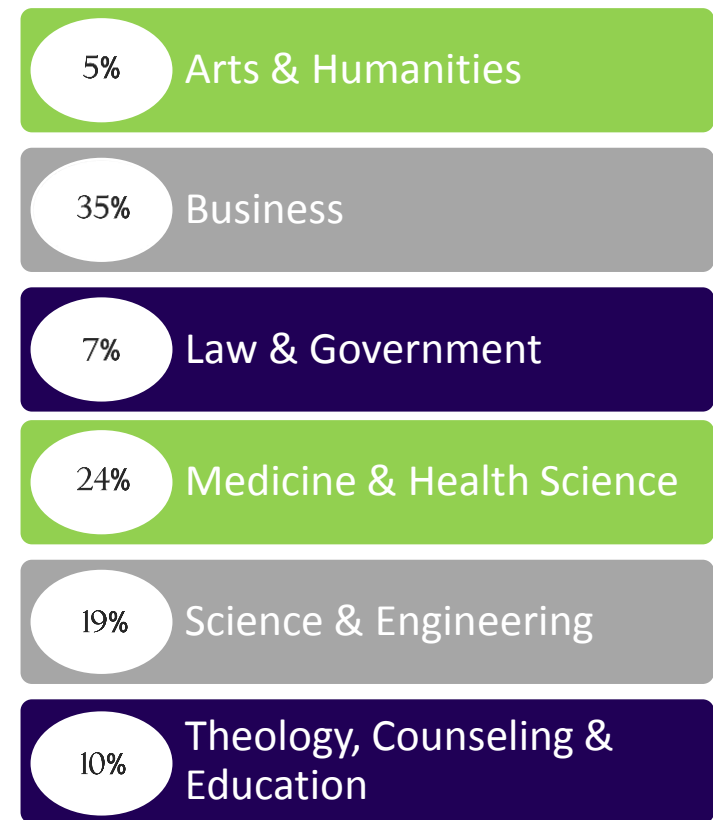

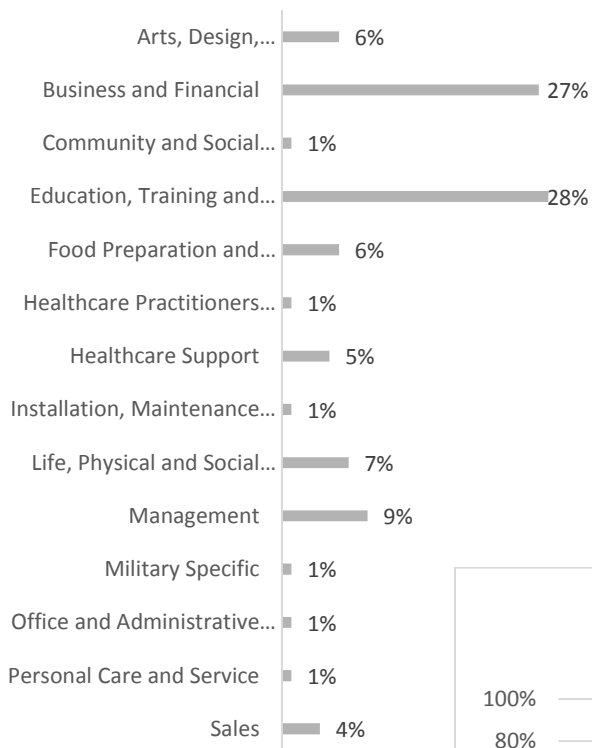

Places of Employment



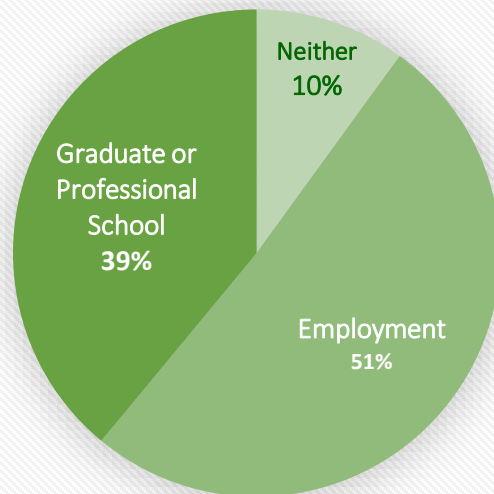


6 Months Later

This 6-month survey was administered to the Class of 2016 approximately 6 months post-graduation. 168 alumni were contacted and 134 of them responded regarding updates on their careers. The overall response rate was 80%.

Survey methods included phone calls, LinkedIn messaging, Facebook messaging, and emails.

Alumni Outcomes



EMPLOYMENT

- 47% working in MS
- 10% working in LA
- 9% working in TX
- Top industry: Business

GRADUATE/ PROFESSIONAL

- 33% awarded a graduate assistantship
- 10% in M.D. programs
- 12% in Ph.D. programs
- 6% in J.D. programs
- 12% in M.Acc. programs

ABROAD

- Two alumni attending graduate programs in Australia and Scotland
- One Fulbright Scholar in Mexico
- One Rhodes Scholar in Oxford, England

The 10% in the “Neither” category reported traveling, job searching, spending time with family, or studying for graduate admissions exams. Of those pursuing further education, 52% had also secured employment or a graduate assistantship.

90% of alumni respondents reported being employed or in graduate/professional school. Of those, 45% graduated in the sciences, 16% graduated in the arts and humanities, and 39% graduated in business, economics, and accounting.
