

ANNUAL P.A.S. YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- **OBJECTIVE:** To award the finest academic graduating high school student(s) with scholarship money that will be used for college education expenses.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** : An applicant must (1) an individual with Filipino ancestry graduating from high school in the academic year that the annual scholarship will be awarded; (2) a resident of Palm Beach County; 3) has been accepted into an accredited college university; and (4) family must be a current member of Philippine American Society (PAS) at the year of the application.
- **SELECTION:** The criteria for the selection of awards are based on four categories:
 - Academic GPA/SAT/Class Rank
 - Achievements -Letters of Recommendations/Academic Awards or Recognition
 - Essay (see attached specifics)
 - Humanitarian/Extra-Curricular Activities

* The Scholarship Committee is composed of five (5) PAS Board of Directors who will review all the applications from qualified individuals. The monetary award is based on the total scores calculated for each candidate. The pool of scholarship money and the number of scholarship money is determined every year at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
