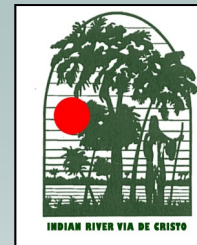

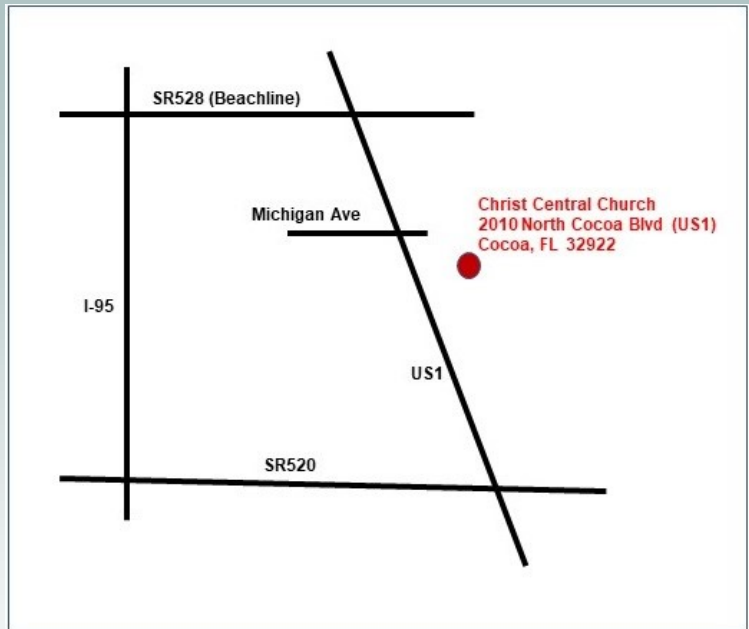

Cocoa, FL 32922

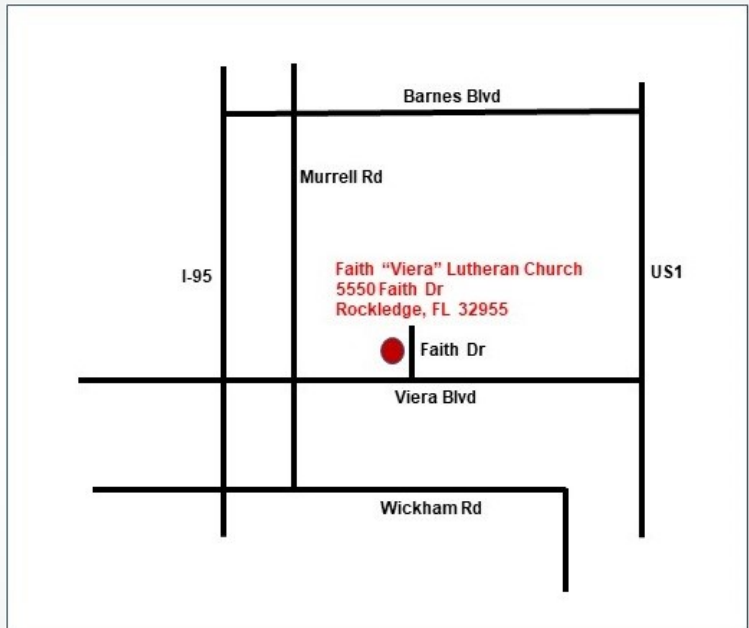
3/4 mile south of SR528 (Beachline) on US1



Map to **Send-off Site:**

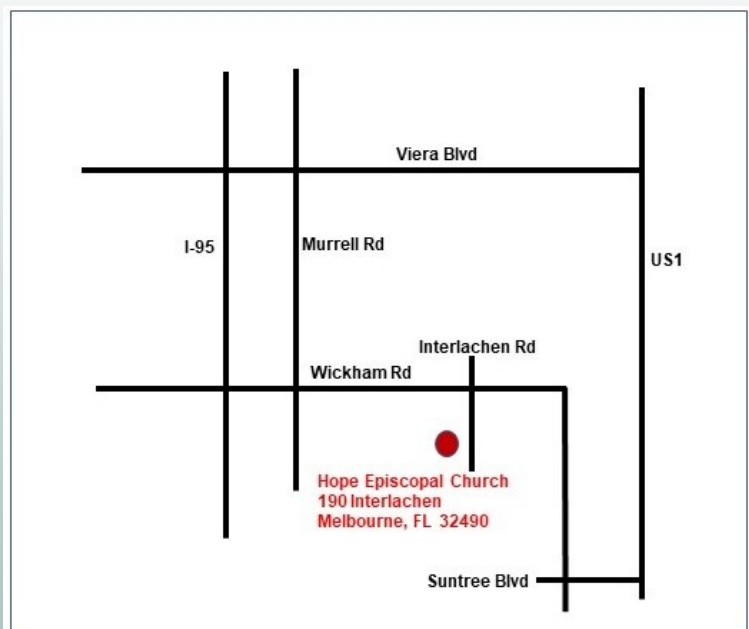
Faith "Viera" Lutheran Church
