## JOB DESCRIPTION

We are currently seeking a Janitor part time for our Community and Residential Services Centre. This is a facility that provides support to those needing emergency beds and or assistance transitioning to their own accommodation, as well as supports for families and community (food bank, etc.).

## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Ensure the general upkeep of the facility, including cleaning floors, washrooms, windows, dusting, collects and disposes of garbage and recycling, vacuums.

Check, clean, move, arrange and dust furniture as required.

Ensure the general upkeep of the external property such as mowing lawns, keeping sidewalks clear of snow and ice, cleaning main floor outside windows, picking up litter, sweeping sidewalks, gardening/watering and pruning shrubs, raking.

Check doors and windows to ensure building security as required during each shift.

Report safety concerns and repair issues to manager immediately upon discovery.

Restock washroom supplies

Spot washes accessible walls, strips, waxes and buffs floors, shampoos carpets.

Request janitorial supplies to be purchased as needed

Perform other position related duties as required.
