

Answers to Commonly Asked Questions

1. Pay registration fee on DragonFly - \$36 plus service fee
 - Pay AAVA registration fee - \$10
2. Registration form – new refs only
3. Referee Agreement
4. W-9
5. Back Ground Check
6. Add phone # and address to Reftown
7. Purchase uniform & equipment
8. Attend
 - New referees must attend 1 day of training.
 - Includes at least 3 matches
 - Training fee is \$55
 - Send email or note with the date/location you want to attend
9. Complete online referee & scoring clinic by the GHSA deadline date
 - \$25 fine for not completing by deadline
10. Complete the exam online by the GHSA deadline date
 - Not allowed to referee if miss GHSA's deadline date
11. Self-assign MS, 9th, & JV matches on Reftown
 - Instructions will be sent 3 days before it goes live
12. Saturday and varsity matches are assigned by assignor
 - Saturday dates pay about a month after the event
 - Regular matches pay at the end of the season – November
13. JV, 9th & MS mainly play on Mon/Wed
14. Varsity mainly play on Tue/Thur
15. Saturday is normally all day with all levels
16. Most matches start around 5 pm during the week. Some start earlier or later
17. Must be in gym 20 minutes before match time

18. When accepting matches, must accept all matches that are linked. 5, 6, 7 pm. Saturday's are normally all day.

19. There are fines for not showing up on time or not showing at all.

- If you are running late, **PLEASE call**
- That way when coach calls, I can let the coach know you are on your way

20. Referee Match fees – LJ and Scores pay \$10 less than referees

- 2/3 match Varsity \$55
- 2/3 match JV, 9th, MS \$44
- 3/5 match Varsity \$75
- 3/5 match JV, 9th, MS \$67

21. Travel fee

- 1 ref - \$30
- 2 or more - \$20

22. Teams running late

- Allow them to play
- **Email** me within 24 hours the time you conduct coin toss – you will be paid extra
- I don't need a phone call
- If I hear from late team, I will let you know. Otherwise work with the host team to see if they have heard from the late team

23. Uniform

- Solid white polo (no designs) OR Cayan blue, grey or white w/blue piping
- Navy blue dress pants
- Belt loops – black belt
- Solid white tennis shoes (leather or mess)
- Solid white crew socks

24. Patches

- GHSA patch worn on left side of chest
- Only for GHSA matches (9th, JV, Varsity)
- No patches for non GHSA matches

25. Most matches are officiated with just one referee

- Schools provide line judges, scorer, libero tracker and score board operator

26. Turning back a match

- Must turn back within 24 hours of the contest otherwise there is a \$50 fine
