

Richard Haynes of Aynho & the Powys Royal Family

Richard Haines of Aynho was a direct descendant of William Heynes of Stretton and a member of the Heynes family of Shropshire. This Heynes family was directly descended, in an unbroken male line, of **Brochwel Ysgithrog** and the Kings of Powys.

Richard Haynes of Aynho

Richard Haynes of Aynho was baptized on 23 Dec, 1642 at St Giles of the Fields, London, He was the second son of John Haynes of Boxgrove and his wife Elizabeth Stanford.

John Haynes of Boxgrove

John Haynes of Boxgrove was baptized on 24 Aug 1614. He was the son of John Haynes of Huntspill and his wife Margaret Cockayne. After marrying in May 1640 John and his wife Elizabeth Stanford relocated to London where in June 1640 John took the oath and became a member of the London Goldsmith's guild. Less than fifteen months later, in July of 1641, their first child John Haynes of Banbury was baptized at St Bride's Church, just a short walk from Goldsmith's Hall. (25) The following year on 23 Dec 1642 their second son Richard Haynes of Aynho was baptized at St Giles in the Fields, just 1.6 miles from Goldsmith's hall.

John Haynes of Huntspill

John Haynes of Huntspill was baptized on 24 May 1578, also at St. Edmunds, Salisbury, Wiltshire, the son of William Heynes and his wife Elizabeth Mompesson. He married Margaret Cockayne and the couple resided in Huntspill until the 1607 when the Bristol Channel Floods destroyed the area. Their last child John Haynes of Boxgrove was baptized on 24 Aug 1614 at St Mary & St Blaise, Boxgrove.

William Haynes of Stretton

William Haynes was born around 1540, the third son of Richard Heynes (c1505) and his wife Elizabeth Thynne, the grandson of Thomas Heynes (c1475) and his wife Elizabeth Gatacre, and the great grandson of John Heynes of Stretton (c1440). William married Elizabeth Mompesson of Corton, Wiltshire. Their son John Haynes of Huntspill was baptized on 24 May 1578, at St. Edmunds, Salisbury, Wiltshire.
