This is Swampy! Swampy was built by *Steady Chameleon* as part of Balranald's Main Street Revitalisation Project, a new play structure installed outside the Senior Citizen's building in the shape of a Southern Bell Frog, measuring 2.5m wide and 4.5m long.

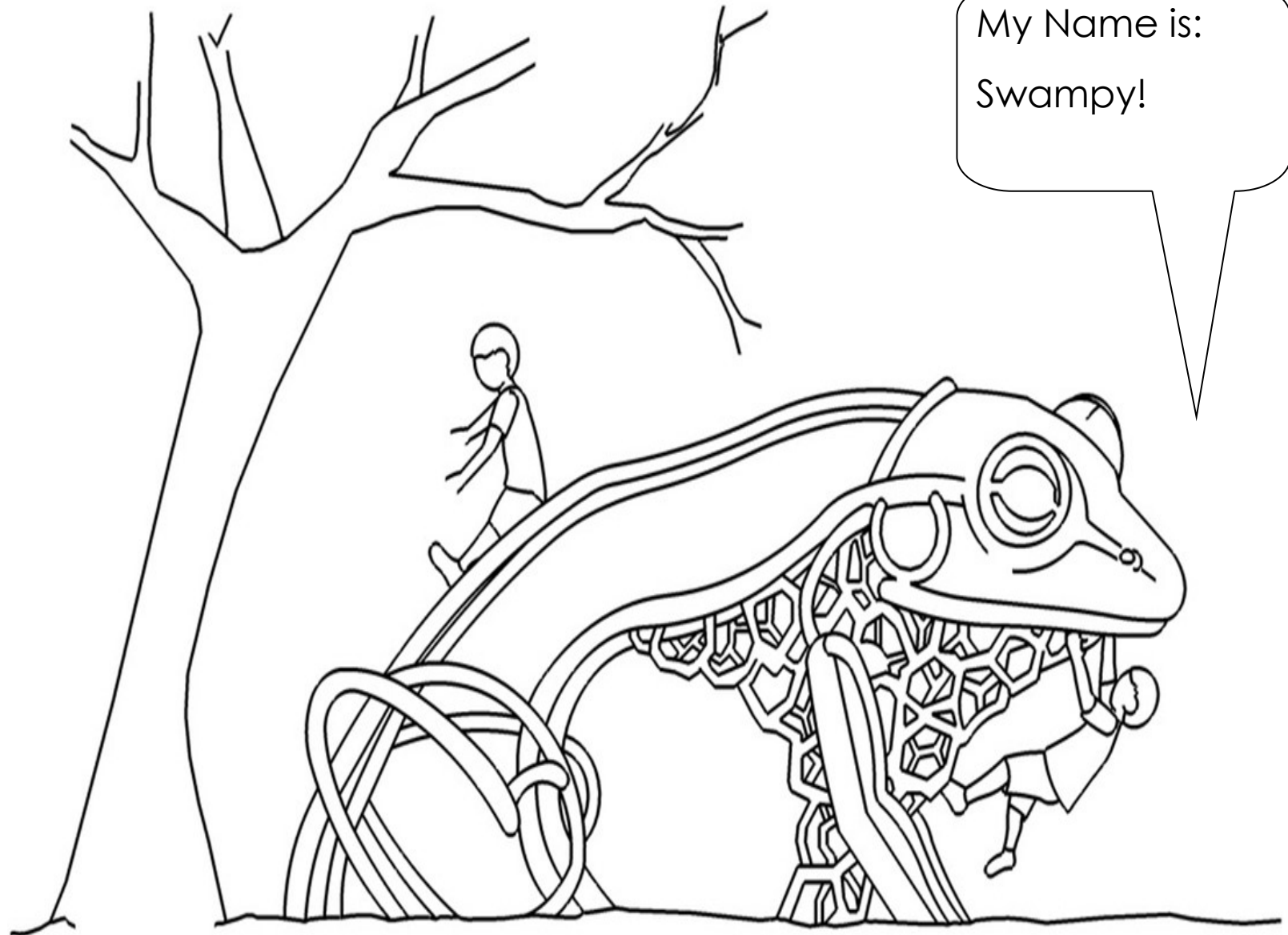
The Southern Bell Frog is special to Balranald because this is one of the few areas lucky enough to still have large numbers of the frog.

The Southern Bell Frog is endangered. They are only found in south-eastern Australia in wetland habitats.

The Southern Bell Frog is also known as the growling grass frog because of the sound of its call:

*Waaaaaah, waaaaaah
rah-rah-rah-rah-rah*

It is bright green in colour with splotches of gold, bronze and black along its back and bright turquoise on the back of its thighs. It can change colour rapidly when subject to heat or bright lights and often turns dark brown during the day. But you can colour in this frog picture any colour you
