MEAL DEAL & FOOD

Adult - \$70/pp (BYO plate, cup, bowl, knife, fork, spoon & tea towel)

Children U/12 - \$50/pp (BYO plate, cup, bowl, knife, fork, spoon & tea towel)

This includes large serves and 2nds if available of hot breakfast, lunch and dinner (2 course) Sat& Sun, and hot breakfast and lunch Monday = 8 good sized meals. Tea & Coffee all weekend.

Individual items/meals available for non-meal deal holders at canteen prices.

YARDING & FEES

Yards are available @ \$10/yard for duration of camp, nonrefundable.

Due to limited yards, priority will be given to one yard per rider, 2nd horses will be accommodated IF yards available. You are strongly <u>encouraged to BYO yards</u>, you will not be charged for bringing your own yards.

NOTE – Electric fencing and chain yards not permitted as per PCAV ruling

Please clean yards and yarded areas to the manure trailers as indicated on the grounds. All pony club cards will be held until yards and area are cleaned and inspected.

Showers, toilets and camping available on grounds. Camp sites are free and some fire wood will be available on the grounds for camping, but please keep in mind this is for everyone, and we appreciate you sharing and not burning large fires 24/7 so there is enough for everyone.



IMPORTANT CAMP INFO:

- All riders are requested to wear suitable attire (jodhpurs, polo shirt, and windcheaters) approved riding helmet and fully soled riding boots.
- > Grouping will be according to ability, ages, and PC grading.
- > We prefer all horses to be graded or assessed for suitability by DC.
- > MUST bring –
- Pony Club Card
- Medical Arm band (or equivalent)
- All horse feed and gear (only hay is available locally)
- Warm clothes and camping gear
- > For your child's show jumping lesson parents are required to report to the instructor to assist.
- Parents of riders who cannot confidently ride independently will be required to accompany their child to all mounted lessons.
- As a courtesy to the instructor, riders not attending a lesson must advise the instructor prior to the lesson, so the lesson will not be held up waiting for them.
- Each club will be rostered to provide helpers for kitchen duties & various jobs on a daily basis throughout the camp.
- > Parents of small children are required to supervise them at all times.

Conditions of Entry

In accordance with PCAV Rules and conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions.

- 1. Before riding: PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.
- 2. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate.
- 3. Entering this camp constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 4. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any group; divide any group; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 5. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
- 6. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
- 7. No stallions, colts or rigs.
- 8. PCAV membership cards will be held till yards are cleaned
- 9. PCAV Lungeing Policy applies.

10. Neither the organising committee of this camp nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

11. Gear check required before riding. Armbands are required to be worn by all riders.
