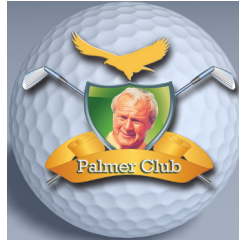
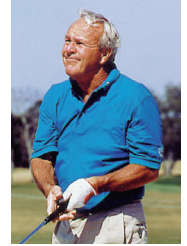

# 2018 Arnie's Cup Match Play Championship

## Rules of the Competition

### Aviara Flight Bracket & Bay Hill Flight Bracket

- Single elimination format in each Flight.
- All matches in each Flight played Net using Palmer Club Course Handicap based on 6-month Low Index effective May 15, 2018 and will remain unchanged throughout the tournament.
- Combo Tee players in th Aviara Flight will use an Adjusted Course Handicap of minus two strokes when playing a Match versus a Blue Tee player. Silver Tee players in th Bay Hill Flight will use an Adjusted Course Handicap of minus four strokes when playing a Match versus a White Tee player.
- All players must play the same tee throughout the tournament.
- All matches must be scheduled by agreement between the two players within the window on the Bracket allowed for each round. All matches should be played within the time frames specified in the schedule. If a match cannot be played within the dates specified it must be played in at least one week. If one player cannot complete the round in one week he will be disqualified.
- In each match the player with the higher course handicap will receive the difference between his course handicap or adjusted course handicap as his handicap for the match. For example, a Player with a 20 handicap will receive 4 strokes handicap (2 on the front 9 and 2 on the back nine) from a Player with a 16 handicap.
- Use standard DVGC scorecards for each match. Please indicate the last name of both players in the match and the winner and outcome of each match prominently on the scorecard: e.g. Jones 2 & 1.
- Post the winner's name in the appropriate place on the Bracket posted in the pro shop.
- Put the Scorecard from each match with Two Signatures and Match Result into the Palmer Club Box at conclusion of your round. **DO NOT POST SCORES** from each Match. The Handicap Committee will post the scores from each Match as Tournament Scores. If you do not play all 18 holes leave the holes not played blank on the scorecard. The Committee will complete the scorecard and post the score for each player. **Scorecards must be turned in for each match. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.**
- Match play rules and penalties are different than in stroke play. If there is any question that cannot be resolved, play two balls, record each score and request a ruling at the completion of 18 holes. A copy of the Local Rules is available in the pro shop and may be downloaded from the Palmer Club website, and must be used for each match.
