**Matt 9:9-13 NLT** <sup>9</sup> As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at his tax collector's booth. "Follow me and be my disciple," Jesus said to him. So Matthew got up and followed him.

<sup>10</sup> Later, Matthew invited Jesus and his disciples to his home as dinner guests, along with many tax collectors and other disreputable sinners.

**Hosea 6:4-7, 9 (NLT)** <sup>4</sup> "O Israel and Judah, what should I do with you?" asks the LORD. "For your love vanishes like the morning mist and disappears like dew in the sunlight. <sup>5</sup> I sent my prophets to cut you to pieces— to slaughter you with my words, with judgments as inescapable as light. <sup>6</sup> I want you to show love, not offer sacrifices. I want you to know me more than I want burnt offerings. <sup>7</sup> But like Adam, you broke my covenant and betrayed my trust. ... <sup>9</sup> Priests form bands of robbers, waiting in ambush for their victims.
