Psalms 119:81-88 (NLT)

⁸¹ I am worn out waiting for your rescue, but I have put my hope in your word.⁸² My eyes are straining to see your promises come true. When will you comfort me?⁸³ I am shriveled like a wineskin in the smoke, but I have not forgotten to obey your decrees.⁸⁴ How long must I wait? When will you punish those who persecute me?⁸⁵ These arrogant people who hate your instructions have dug deep pits to trap me.⁸⁶ All your commands are trustworthy.
