Psalms 119:145-152 (NLT)

¹⁴⁵ I pray with all my heart; answer me, LORD! 1 John 1:1-4 (NLT) ¹ We proclaim to you the one who existed from the beginning, whom we have heard and seen. We saw him with our own eyes and touched him with our own hands. He is the Word of life.² This one who is life itself was revealed to us, and we have seen him. And now we testify and proclaim to you that he is the one who is eternal life.
