Matthew 13:24-30

Here is another story Jesus told: “The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field (25) But while the man slept, his enemy came and sowed tares (weeds resembling wheat) among the wheat, then went away. (26) But when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared. (27) So the servants of the owner came to him and said to him 'Sir, the field where you planted the good seed is full of weeds! Where did they come from?' (28) 'An enemy has done this!' the farmer exclaimed. 'Should we pull out the weeds?' they asked. (29) 'No,' he replied, 'you'll uproot the wheat if you do. (30) Let both grow together until the harvest. Then I will tell the harvesters to sort out the weeds, tie them into bundles, and burn them, and to put the wheat in the barn.'”
