THE ANTON BRUCKNER CHORAL FESTIVAL AND COMPETITION

On Thursday, June 8th, the Chamber Singers will return to Florida College to rehearse and prepare for competition in Linz, Austria. The following day, the rest of the FC Chorus will arrive, and then the Chorus and Chamber Singers will spend Friday and Saturday polishing their competitions music. On Sunday, everyone will leave for Miami on the long flight to Germany. The trip will begin in Salzburg, where, after some sight-seeing, we will sing a combined concert before we travel to Linz for competition.

The Chamber Singers will be competing in the “Chamber Ensemble” division against some of the best ensembles in the world. Meanwhile, the chorus will be pulling double duty competing in both the “Chorus” and “Sacred” division. This year will be the first time any Florida College ensemble has competed over-seas.

As you can imagine, the cost of such an endeavor is daunting. Although we have received about \$28,000 through fundraising efforts, the students themselves have had to contribute over \$90,000 collectively to make this trip possible.
