

Overview of Expenses for Illinois FCCLA State Officers for 2020-2021

State Conference 2020 – all expenses are covered by the student, chapter or school

State Officer Uniform –

Female: a red FCCLA blazer, an official FCCLA scarf, a black skirt, black pants, and two white oxford shirts are provided to each officer by the Norma Gill Scholarship and an anonymous donor (total amount of about \$ 200.00). The student is responsible for purchasing black shoes. An officer polo shirt and brief bag (may also be purchased). The total amount incurred by the student is usually around \$ 50.00.

Male: a red FCCLA blazer, an official FCCLA necktie, black pants, two white oxford shirts are provided to each officer by the Norma Gill Scholarship and an anonymous donor (total amount of about \$ 200.00). The student is responsible for purchasing black shoes. An officer polo shirt and brief bag (may also be purchased). The total amount incurred by the student is usually around \$ 50.00.

June Leadership Training – mileage, housing & meals are all covered by the Illinois Assoc. of FCCLA. I make all the hotel arrangements for you. We do ask each state officer to bring a couple of food items for one of the lunches (chips, cookies, etc.). Otherwise, everything is covered by FCCLA.

Summer Leadership Camp – mileage, housing & meals are all covered by the Illinois Assoc. of FCCLA.

National Leadership Conference – The entire conference (travel, hotel room, meals, sightseeing, and conference registration) is estimated at about \$ 1200.00/person. The Illinois Foundation for FCCLA and the Illinois Association of FCCLA will give each officer and their adviser an amount of money to put towards expenses for the year. The amount will be announced prior to State Conference. Of the total amount given, 66% will be paid in a check that the adviser will receive at June Training. The remaining amount or up to 34% will be received at State Conference 2021 (see State Officer Leadership Performance Rubric). Schools/chapters handle the balance of the trip to Nationals in many ways...some districts pay the remainder; some chapters fundraise the money; other schools the adviser's way is paid, and the student owes the remaining amount.

ICCCTSO (IL Coordinating Council for Career & Tech. Student Organizations) Seminar - Each student & adult attending is required to pay a \$ 25.00 registration fee...but beyond that, all expenses (mileage, hotel room and meals) are covered by a grant from the Illinois State Board of Education and the Illinois Association of FCCLA.

September & January Executive Council Meetings – mileage, housing & meals are all covered by the Illinois Association of FCCLA. I make all the hotel arrangements for you.

Ignite! Conference – state officers/advisers should be registered for the conference, but you do NOT pay the registration fee. Illinois FCCLA covers the cost of the state officer's hotel rooms. Adviser's hotel rooms and mileage are the responsibility of the school/chapter/individual.

Fall Leadership Meeting – state officers/advisers should be registered for the Meeting but do NOT pay the registration fee for the meeting they preside over. Illinois FCCLA will make and pay for any hotel arrangements that might be needed for the state officer and the adviser for the night before. Mileage and meals are at the expense of the school/chapter/individual

State Conference 2021 - state officers/advisers should be registered for the conference, but you do NOT pay the registration fee. housing & meals are all covered by the Illinois Assoc. of FCCLA. I make all the hotel arrangements for you. Mileage is at the expense of the school/chapter/individual. Advisers should plan to bring a chaperone to help with the other students from the school since state officers & advisers will be tied up with responsibilities of the conference. Advisers are responsible for making the hotel reservations for their chapter.
